Thank you for your email of 5 May 2022 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"Can you please provide the following information including the relevent referances.

If a Regular Service Member has previously recieved an award under AFCS 2005 which includes a Garunteed Income Payment (GIP) would they be eliagable to join the Reserve Forces upon leaving Regular servise?

Additionally, would there be any implications to their GIP as a Reservist, or would this continue to be payed in a simular manner as to Armed Forces Pension Schemes?"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). I would like to apologise for the time it has taken to respond to your request.

Section 1 of the FOIA gives an applicant the right to access recorded information held by public authorities at the time the request is made and does not require public authorities to answer questions, provide explanations or give opinions, unless this is recorded information held. I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence holds no recorded information that would provide an answer to the question you have asked in your request. You may find it useful to know that The Information Commissioners Office publishes guidance on how to make requests for information under the Freedom of Information Act at https://ico.org.uk/ which you may find helpful in any follow up requests for information.
