## **JUDGMENT**

**Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21** 

- 1. The claim was issued in the Southampton Employment Tribunals on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £2083.33 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £1531.40.
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £480.77.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £4095.50 in total.
- 6. As the Claimant did not have 2 years' service, she may neither claim unfair dismissal nor a redundancy payment.
