The Embassy of Switzerland in the United Kingdom presents its compliments to the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office and has the honour to refer to the Temporary Agreement between the Swiss Confederation ("Switzerland") and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland ("United Kingdom") on Services Mobility, signed in London on 14 December 2020 ("SMA").

The Embassy of Switzerland in the United Kingdom has the honour to propose, on behalf of the Swiss Federal Council, that the Parties hereby agree, in accordance with Article 19 paragraph 6 of the SMA that the SMA shall end on 31 December 2025, unless the Parties agree otherwise.

If the aforementioned proposal to prolong the duration of the SMA is acceptable to the United Kingdom, this Note and the United Kingdom's reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between Switzerland and the United Kingdom, which shall enter into force on the first day of the first month following the date of receipt of the United Kingdom's reply.
