Thank you for your email of 4th July 2022 requesting the following information:

I am requesting the following information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000): The number of students who have accessed the UKHOMOD site in the academic year of 2021-2022.

If any students have been denied access to the site prior to entry due to them being Russian or Chinese nationals.

A search for the information has now been completed within the UKHO, and I can confirm that most of the information in scope of your request is held.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
