"Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 please would you provide me with a comprehensive list of all MOD properties for sale in the south off the UK especially on the coast.

We would like all the information of any MOD sites/properties potentially for sale that would facilitate the building of accomodation and provision of watersports activities for sports holidays firstly in the south and south west of England and secondly in the whole of the UK.

We would also like information on potential sites overseas such as Gibraltar, Indian Ocean, anywhere etc."
