Thank you for your email of 29 August 2022 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD), in response to my letter of 25 August 2022 seeking further information about the award of the General Service Medal (GSM) with clasp for the Campaign in Dhofar Oman.

You requested the following information:

" I am really surprised, at the number of Total medals of GSM 1962 medals issued, in the Army, as at the time I was there in March-June 1973, there were only 27members of the RA Cracker Bty and an average of 30 From Soundrangers.

As we did a 3 month tour, times this figure by 4 =228 a year for 7 years = 1596

The SAS were at Sqn strength so 240 a year x7 = 1680. The REs had a Sqn for about 2 years so approx 640 in the 2 years, and then only a handful of REME and Royal Signals, and RAC troop.

I estimate that there were less than 4000 during the total war, unless you are counting the SAS who were there before the War! Do you have a breakdown of those Regiments, year by year?

This would be helpful, as I am trying to compile a Historical record of all those in the Army who served in the 'secret War' before it fades into oblivion!"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the MOD and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held. I must first apologise, as my reply of 25 August 2022 was inaccurate, the figure had been inflated due to the fact that there are duplicate sheets for many of the medal rolls which had unfortunately been included in the original count. The numbers have now been recounted taking into account the duplicate sheets and the figure is 2,594.

The numbers on the manual medal rolls are provided by regiment below, it was not possible to count them year on year as the years were not recorded in any consistent pattern.

Please see a breakdown by regiment for awards of the GSM with Clasp Dhofar post 2005 held on the Medal Office Database which still stands at 171. The ones titled CLASP TO GSM 1962 – DHOFAR are where the individual already held the GSM 1962 with a different clasp that would have been earned prior to the Dhofar conflict, so only the clasp was issued. The ones titled GSM 1962 – DHOFAR are where the individual had not been previously issued the GSM 1962 so was issued the GSM 1962 with clasp Dhofar.

It is not possible to break the RAF into units, they are recorded as RAF on the database and on the Joint Personnel Administration System.
