# JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's application to amend the name of the Respondent is successful and the Respondent's name is as set out in the heading of this Judgment.
2. The Claim for unpaid holiday pay is well-founded and the Respondent shall pay the Claimant **£457.69 gross** in respect thereof.
3. The Claim for Wrongful Dismissal (Notice Pay) is well-founded and the Respondent shall pay the Claimant **£1,634.60 gross** in respect thereof.
4. It is declared that the Respondent made unlawful deductions from the Claimant's wages and the Respondent shall pay the Claimant **£2,898.56 gross** in respect thereof.
5. The Claims for breach of contract are well-founded and the Respondent shall pay the Claimant **£273.67** (unpaid expenses) and **£176.54** (unpaid pension contribution).

6. The total sum payable pursuant to this Judgment is **£5,441.06** and of that sum **£4,990.85** is subject to deductions for tax and national insurance.
