This in relation to your request of 29 April 2022:

“We are library suppliers and we have customers who require this information. The last one we published was 2017 (RAF personnel details of senior officers (1-star rank and above) serving in the RAF as of the 4th January 2018). Please see a pdf copy of this attached. As per our original enquiry we need: RAF senior officers (1-star rank and above) serving in the RAF as of the January 2019 RAF senior officers (1-star rank and above) serving in the RAF as of the January 2020 RAF senior officers (1-star rank and above) serving in the RAF as of the January 2021 RAF senior officers (1-star rank and above) serving in the RAF as of the January 2022.”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).
