We refer to your email dated 8th September 2022 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on 8th September 2022.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

Please could you provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act regarding the age of serving police officers: A breakdown of the age and rank of serving MDP police officers aged 55 and above. If possible analysed by each year of age, e.g. 7 aged 56, (1 inspector, 6 constables).

If this detail is not available, as it is too time consuming or likely to identify individuals, then can it be analysed by age groups (and their ranks) 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65 and over.

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
