Thank you for your e-mail, if the application were to be approved the first 4 items highlighted below would be required as works provided by the developer through a S278 agreement, rather than a financial contribution. I put them in the Heads of Terms marked as off-site highway works as they are not within the red line of the application, it maybe that the inspector is minded to condition these works rather than have them in the S106.

In order to understand if these works are deliverable the applicant needs to provide more information as stipulated in my response dated the 19<sup>th</sup> of January. I had a meeting with the transport consultant yesterday and he is undertaking the survey work required for the cycleways, the design of the crossing and will be getting the proposed works safety audited. They are also reviewing the access arrangements. I will be able to define the works when the information is provided.

Thank you for your email of the 18 January 2023 which provided a list of potential items for a Section (s)106 on a without prejudice basis in relation to the current application for land west of Thaxted Road, Saffron Walden.

As you may be aware the current planning application is being considered under s62A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended). When a Council considers a planning application it can make a recommendation 'subject to' the completion of a s106 agreement. However, under s62A the Inspector needs to issue the decision with their report. As a result if the s106 agreement is to be a material consideration in the determination of the application then PINS needs to have a completed legal agreement prior to the determination of the application.

Whilst the Inspector has yet to reach a decision on their recommendation we are writing to the Applicant and those parties that have indicated the need for a planning obligation to advise them of this requirement. Accepting that the information provided in your email of the 18 January 2023 is on a without prejudice basis and the subsequent in principle objection to the scheme from ECC (Highways), there are a number of requests (see table below) where the detail/ contribution you are seeking is currently undefined. Should the Applicant choose to progress with a legal agreement so that it can be a material consideration the Inspector would be most grateful if you could provide the relevant level of detail to ensure that, should consent be granted, the scheme would be appropriately mitigated.
