Thank you for your emails of 6 May 2022 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"I am looking for some assistance with your organisation's Spend/Transparency data, available on the following weblink:

https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/mod-spending-over-25000-january-to-december-2019

There appears to be no file available for the month of February 2022. Could you advise when the file will be made available to view online? Would it be possible for you to email me a copy of the February 2022 file please & Thank you."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

However, the information you have requested falls entirely within the scope of an absolute exemption under Section 21 of the FOIA as it is reasonably accessible by other means. As Section 21 is an absolute exemption, there is no requirement to consider the public interest in making the decision to withhold the information.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may raise your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
