## Dear

Thank you for your e-mail of 10 May 2022 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"1. How many staff working for Veterans UK are a veteran of the UK's armed forces?

2. How many staff working for Veterans UK are a veteran of a foreign nation's armed forces?"

I am treating your request as a request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. I can confirm that no information in scope of your request is held.

Information about the former professions of employees is not routinely recorded on the Human Resources system. Veterans UK do not internally record this information about their employees and would have to ask former veterans to volunteer this information.

Under Section 16 of the FOIA (advice and assistance) you might be interested to know that Stephanie Peacock MP recently asked a question in the House of Commons regarding the numbers of Veterans employed as civil servants by the MOD. Please note that any request for an internal review should be made within 40 working days of the date of this response.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may raise your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
