I am writing to object to the application to construct a solar farm consisting of ground mounted solar arrays together with battery storage, inverter cabins, a substation and CCTV cameras on land near Pelham Substation, Manuden, CM23 1BJ.

The reasons for my objections are:

The proposed project creates an industrial zone within a beautiful rural environment that will then be spoiled for generations to come.

The extent of the project is hugely disproportionate in size relative to the natural environment.

The long and extensive construction period will lead to a completely unacceptable amount of heavy construction traffic on entirely unsuitable country lanes.

This same proposal has already been rejected once - there is zero practical difference between that proposal and this. I urge you strongly to reject this proposal also.
