## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: MENTAL HEALTH SICKNESS ABSENCE.

We refer to your email dated 10<sup>th</sup> November 2022 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the 10<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

I would like to know the number of days taken off by police officers reporting sickness absence with a reason of anxiety, stress, depression or other psychiatric illness.

I would like this information for each of the last three calendar years as follows: 2020, 2021 and 2022

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

Breakdown of sickness absence attributed to Anxiety, depression, stress by calendar days and years for Ministry of Defence Police Officers only is as follows:

| Calendar Year       | Calendar Days Lost |
|---------------------|--------------------|
| 2020                | 8,571              |
| 2021                | 9,532              |
| 2022 (until 31 Oct) | 9,838              |
