## PRISON SERVICE PAY REVIEW BODY 2023-24 PAY ROUND

Thank you for your letter of 27 January regarding the Government's evidence submission to the PSPRB for the 2023-24 pay round.

I am grateful for the continued dedication of the PSPRB in carrying out such valuable work, and appreciate the frustration caused by the delay to the submission of our evidence, and the impact that this has had on the overall pay round timeline.

I am pleased that our evidence has now been submitted to the PSPRB and published, following confirmation from OME of the formal evidence exchange having taken place.

I recognise that the delay to our evidence submission will mean the PSPRB's report will likely also be delayed, and I welcome any contribution you and your members can play in delivering recommendations to Government at the earliest opportunity.
