The declaration and decision of the Employment Tribunal is that:

The Respondent breached the contract of employment by constructively dismissing the Claimant and the Claimant is entitled to payment of his notice pay.

The Respondent discriminated against the Claimant because of his nationality in breach of section 13 Equality Act 2010.

The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant;

- a) The net sum of £1,725 for loss of earnings in connection with the claim discrimination
- b) The gross sum of £345 for unpaid notice pay.
- c) The sum of £990 for injury to feelings.
