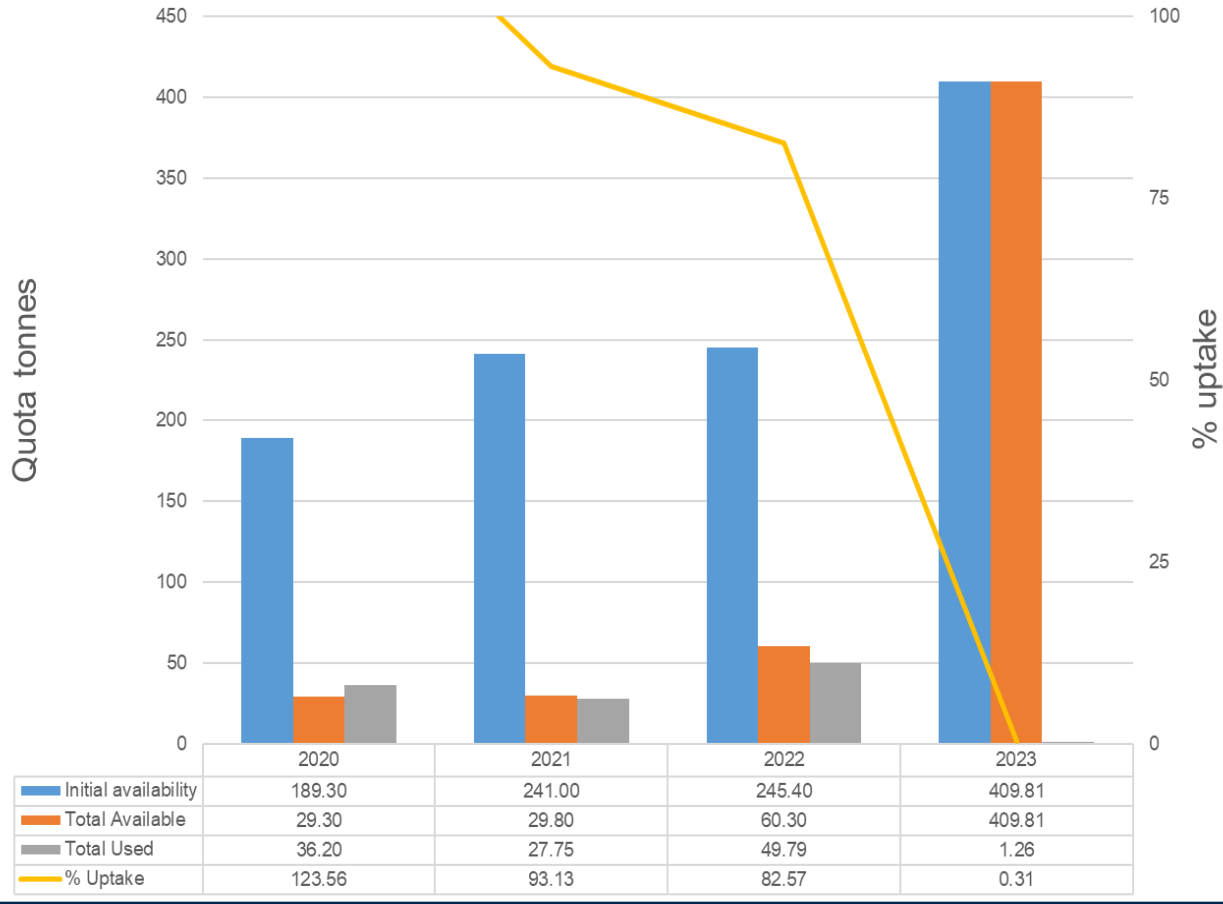

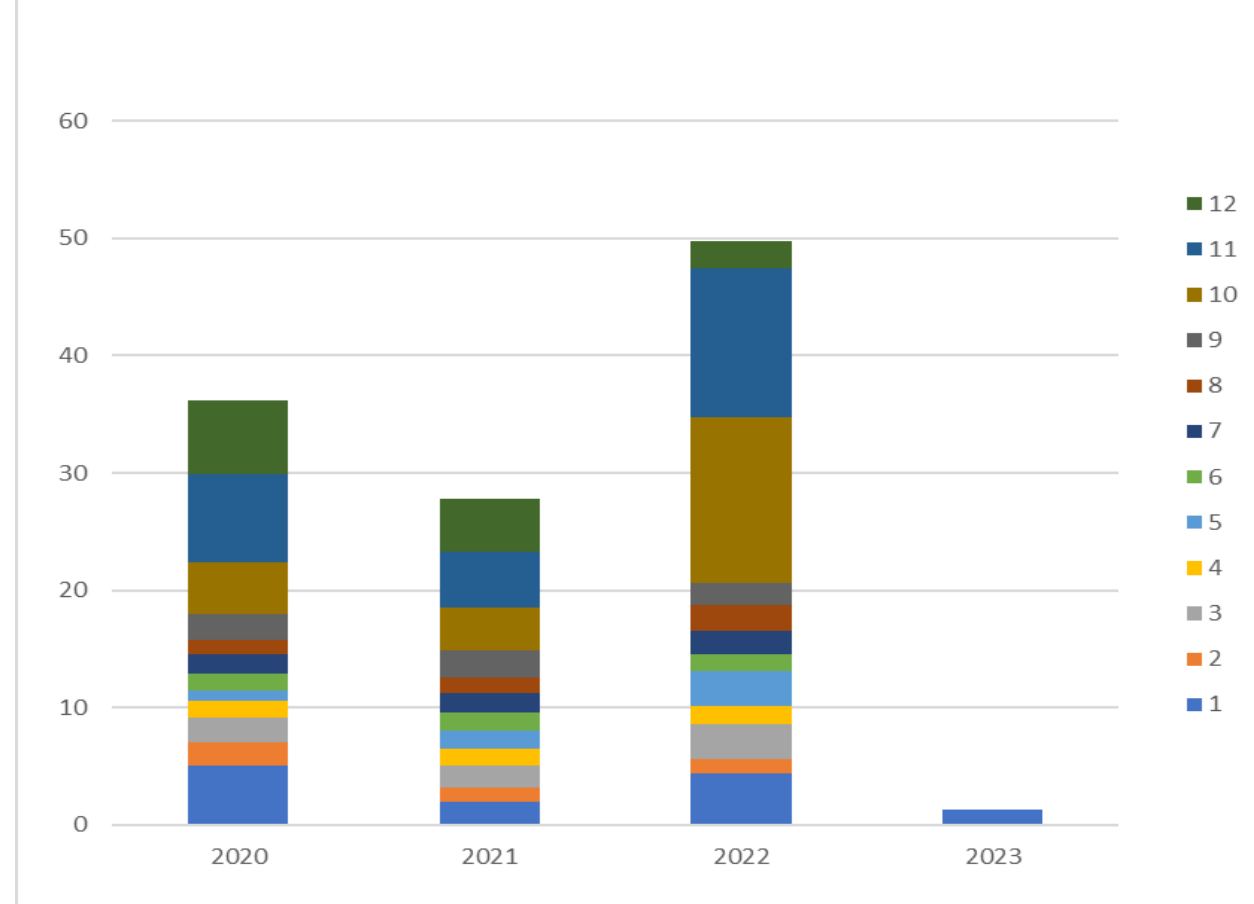

Monthly Uptake by Year - NS COD



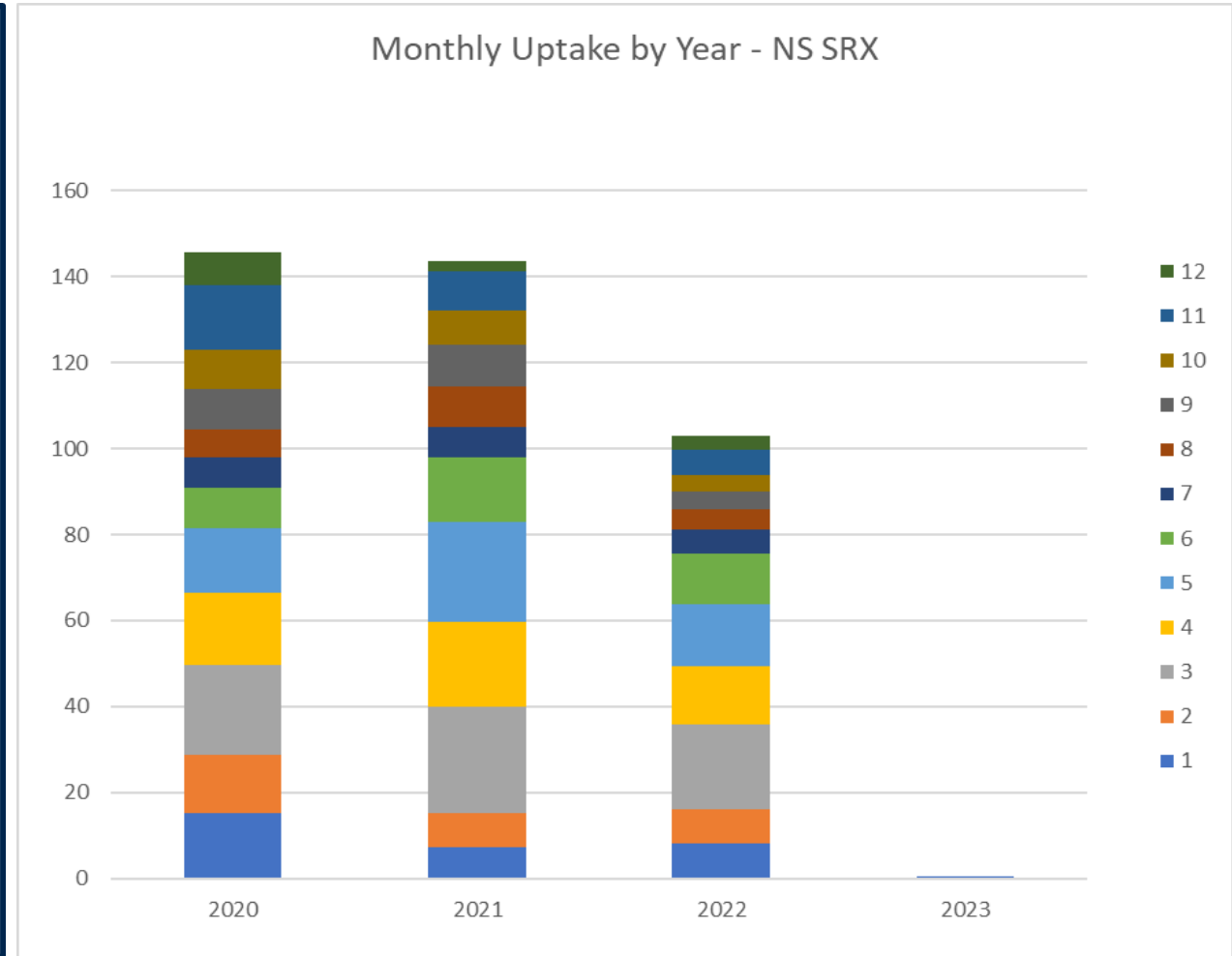
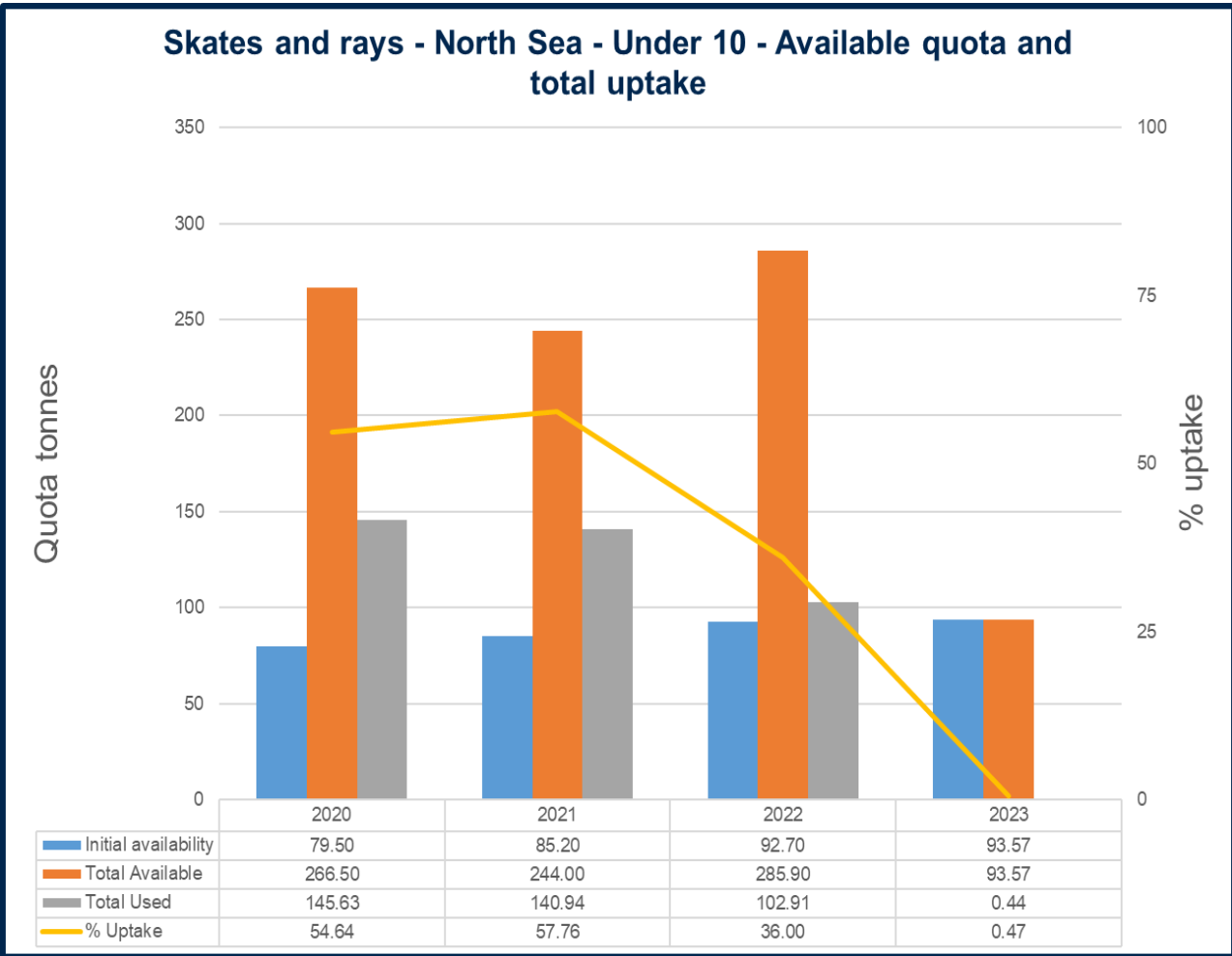

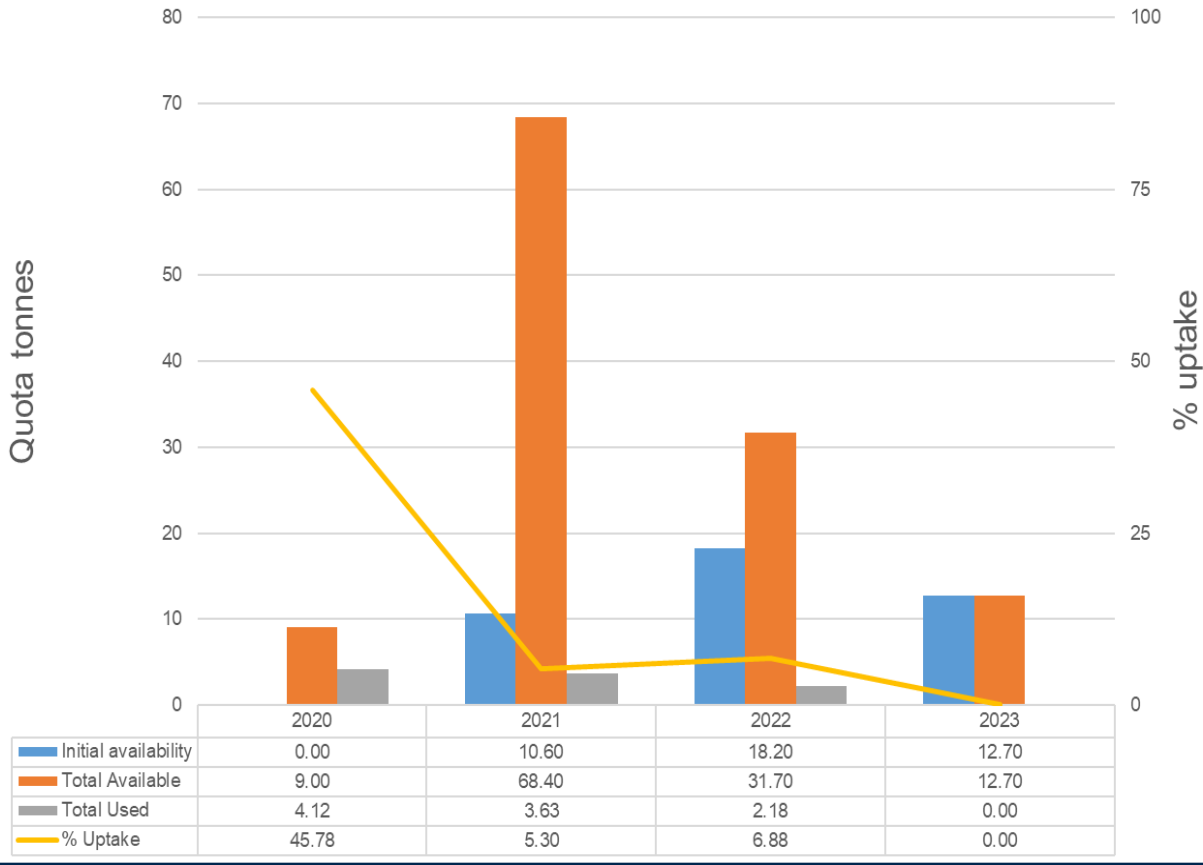

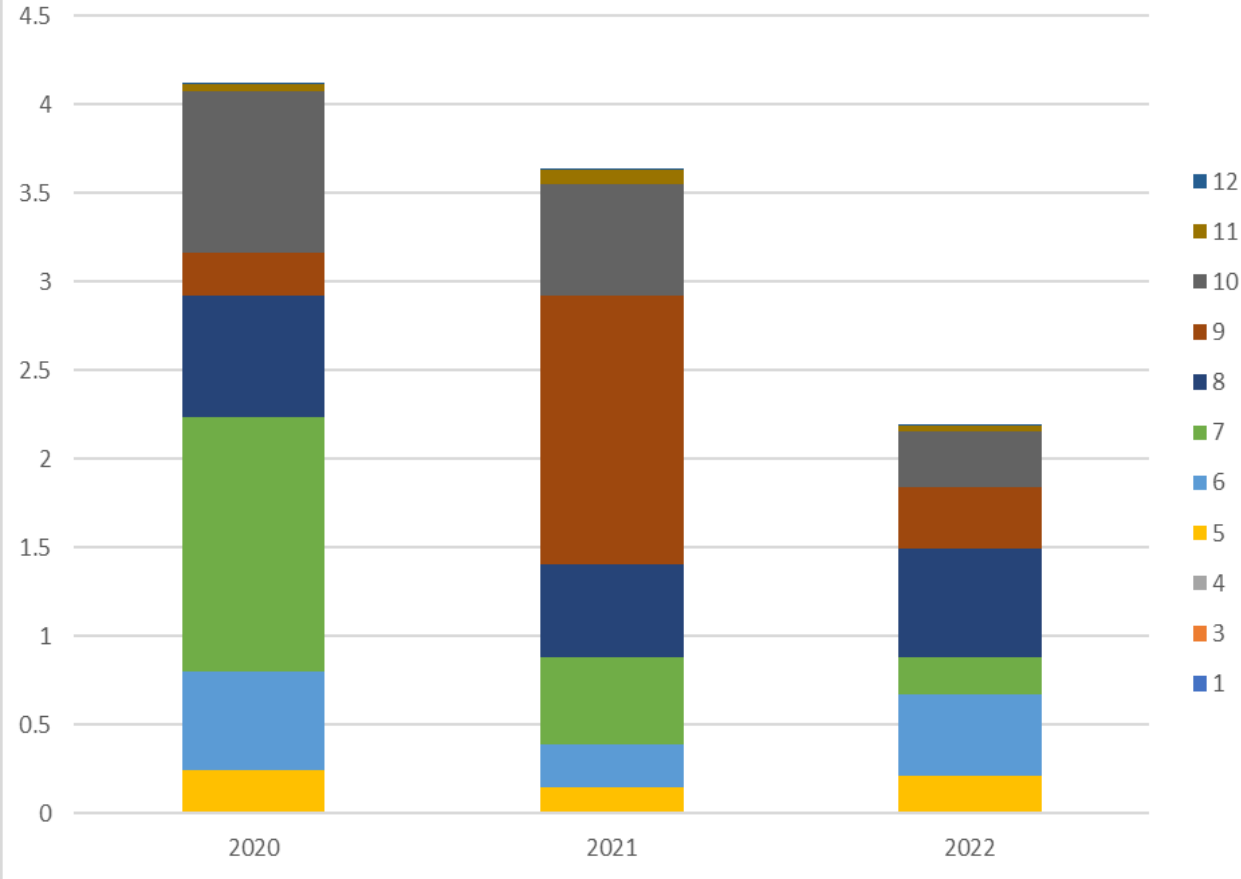

As per the provisional Secretary of State Determination:

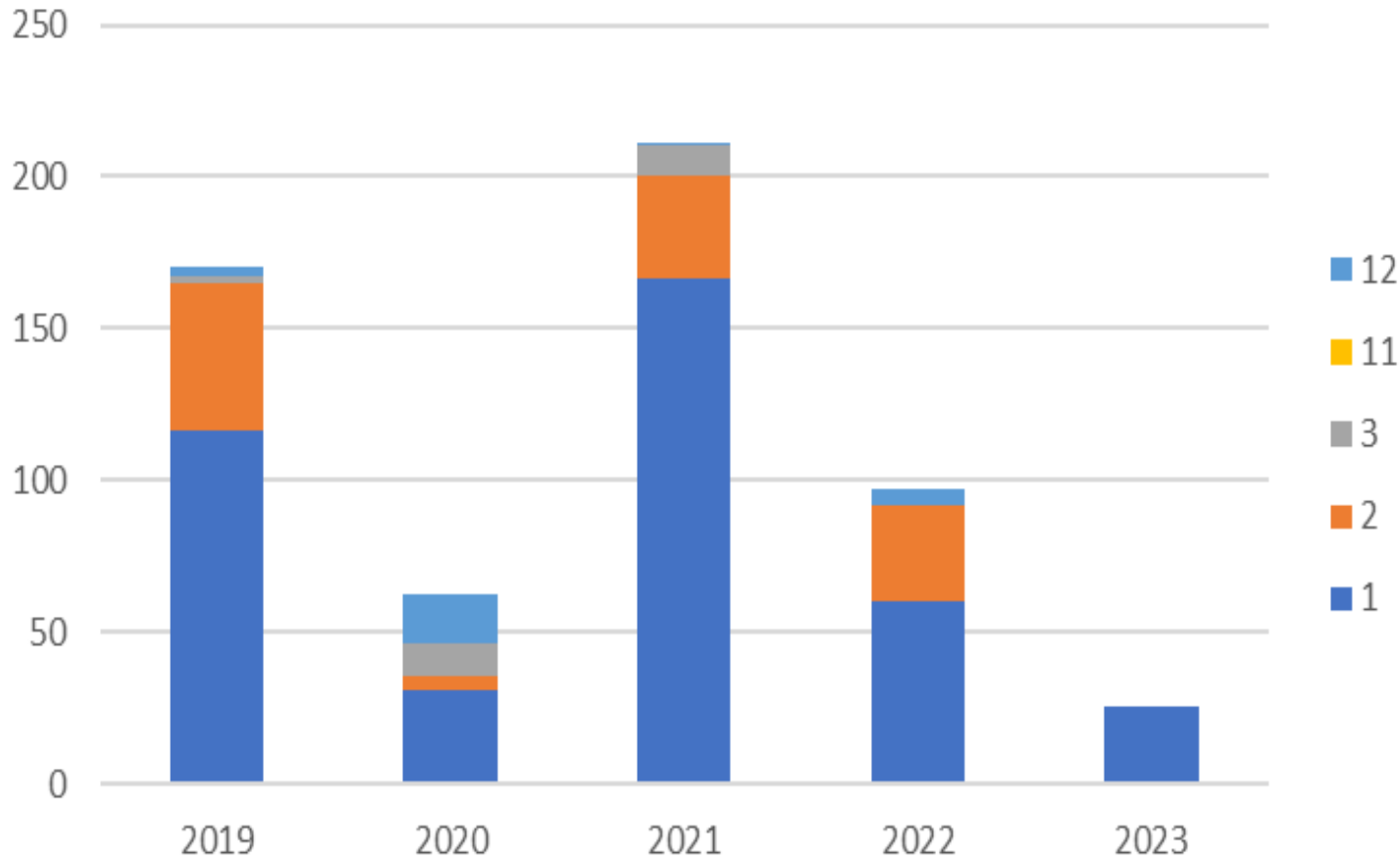
UK Allocation – 2,781t

1. May not be targeted in the areas covered by this TAC until the prohibitions in the relevant UK and European Union laws have been removed.
2. 2. In European Union waters a maximum conservation reference size of 100cm shall be respected. In UK waters a maximum size of 100cm shall apply once the prohibition in the UK's law is removed. Additional measures may be applied.

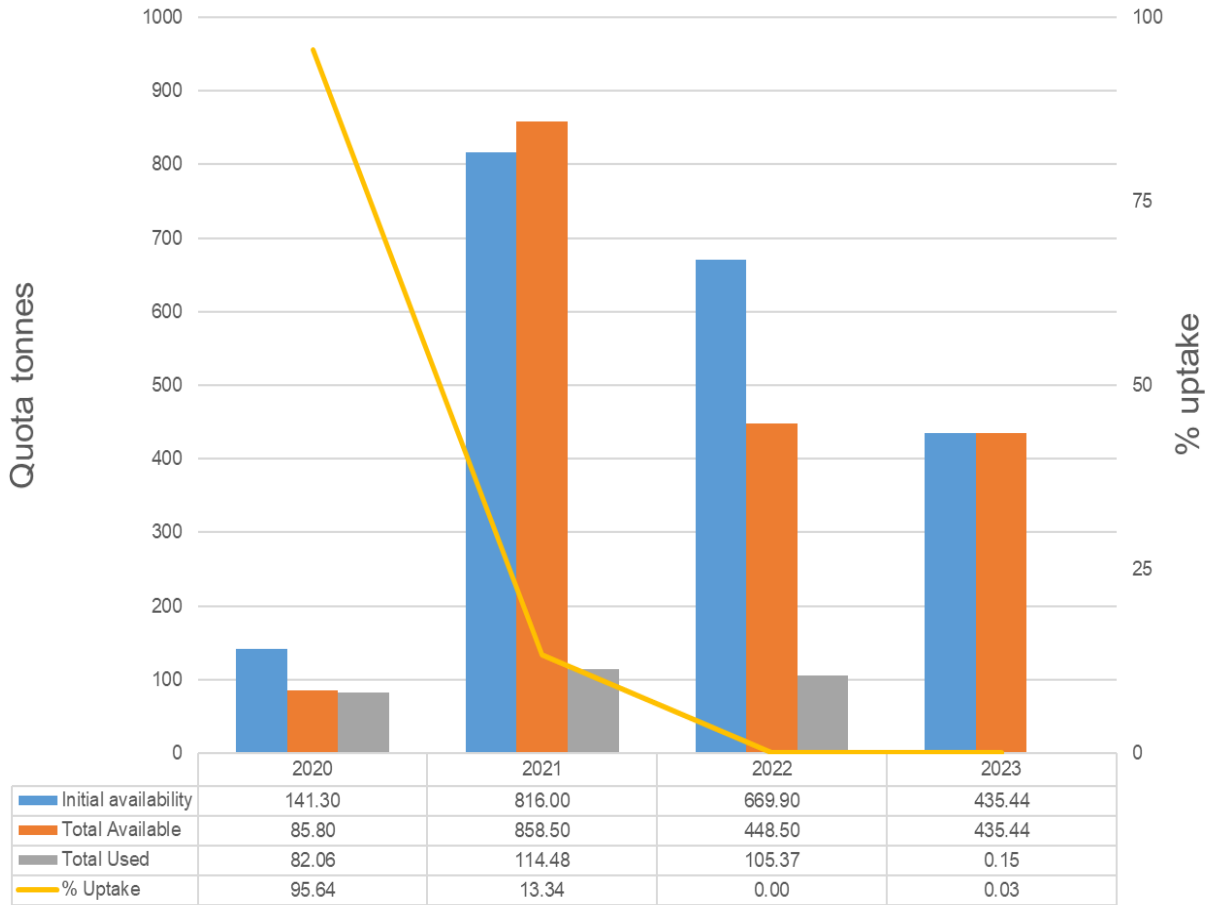

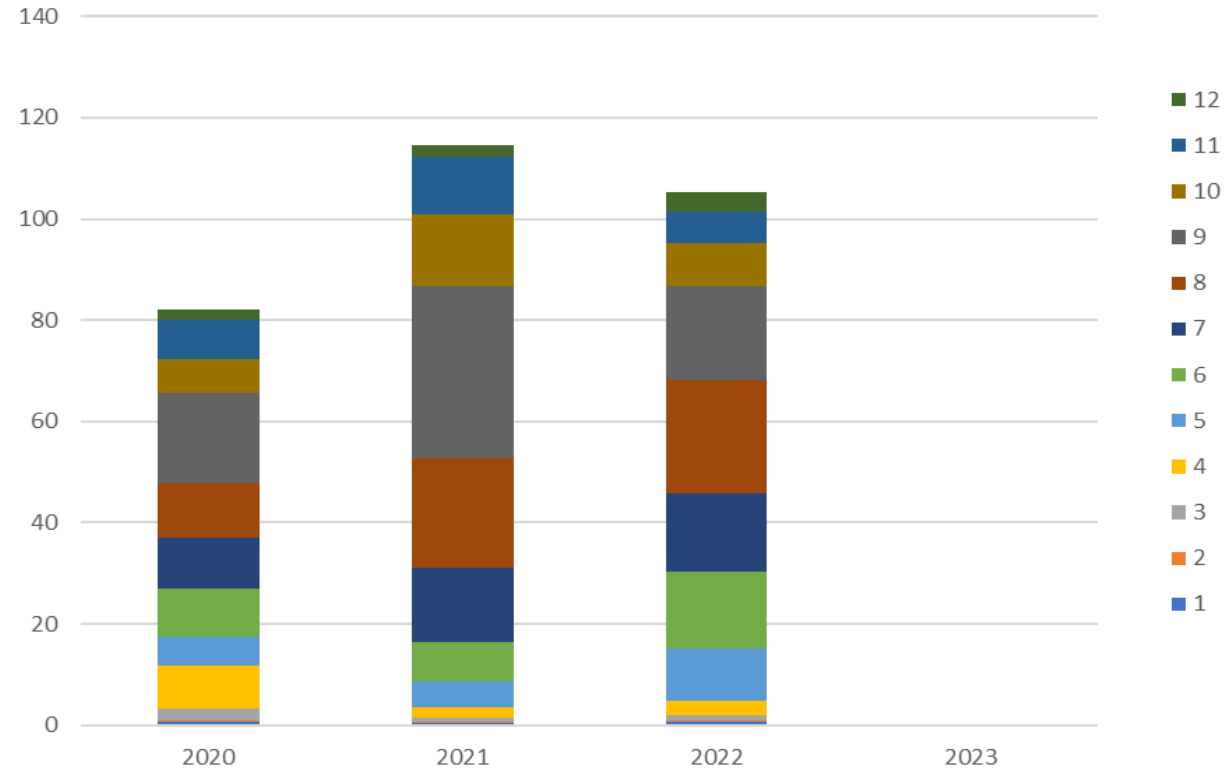

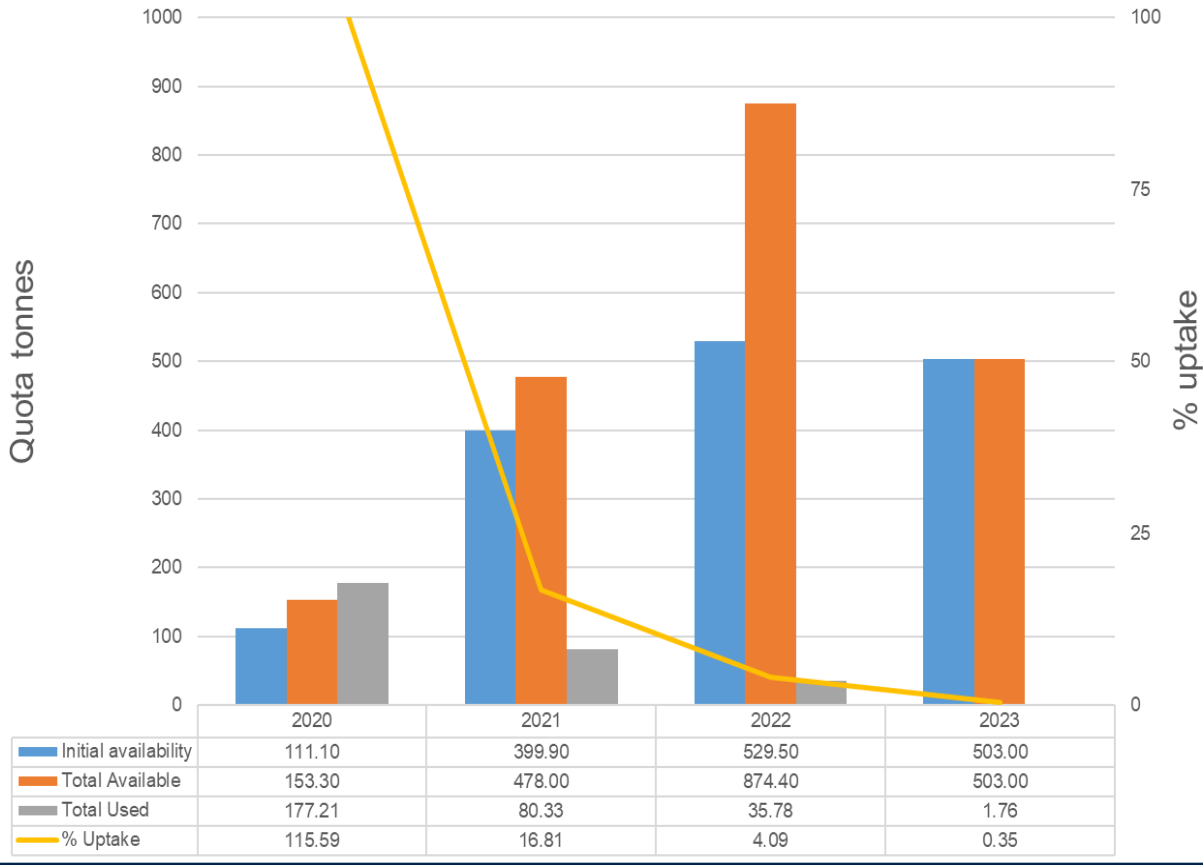

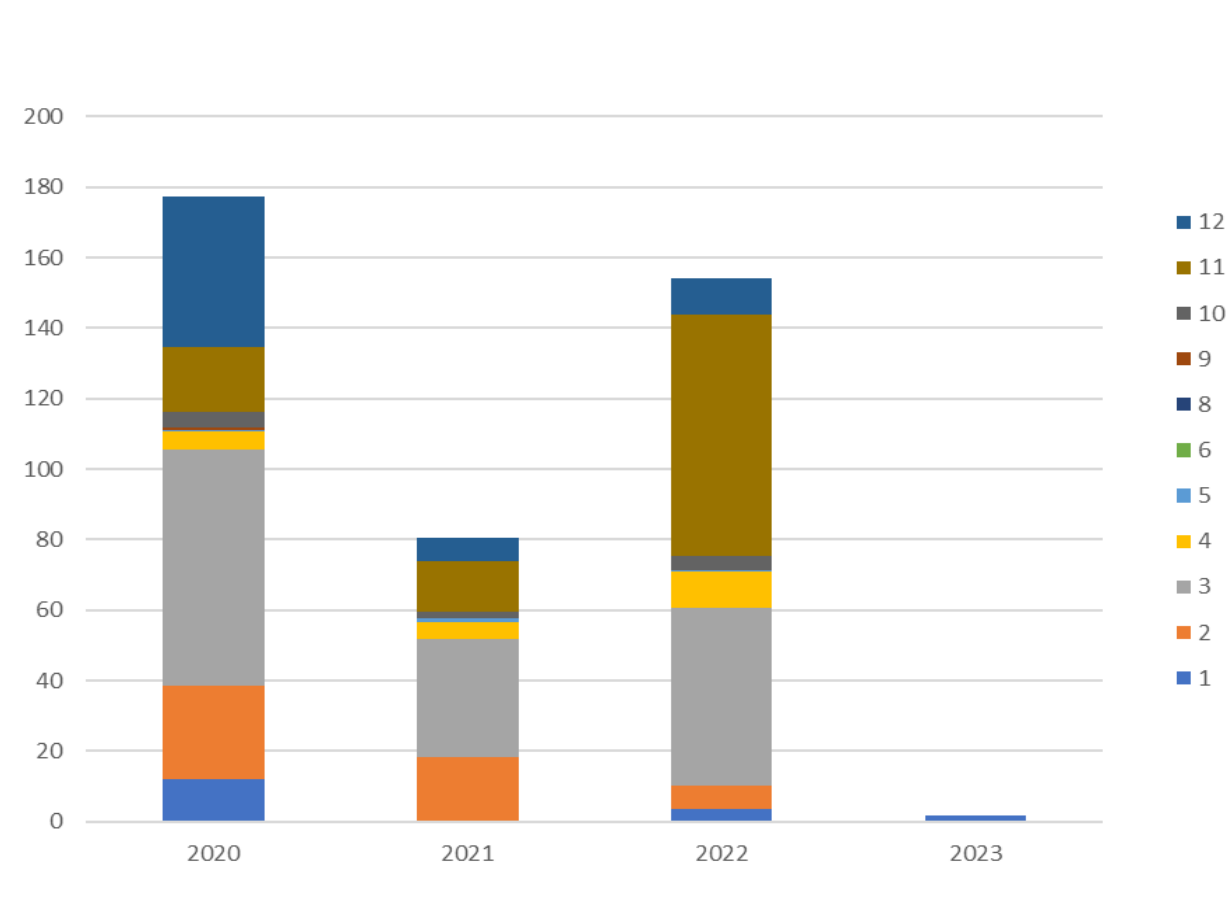
Herring 4c / 7d
