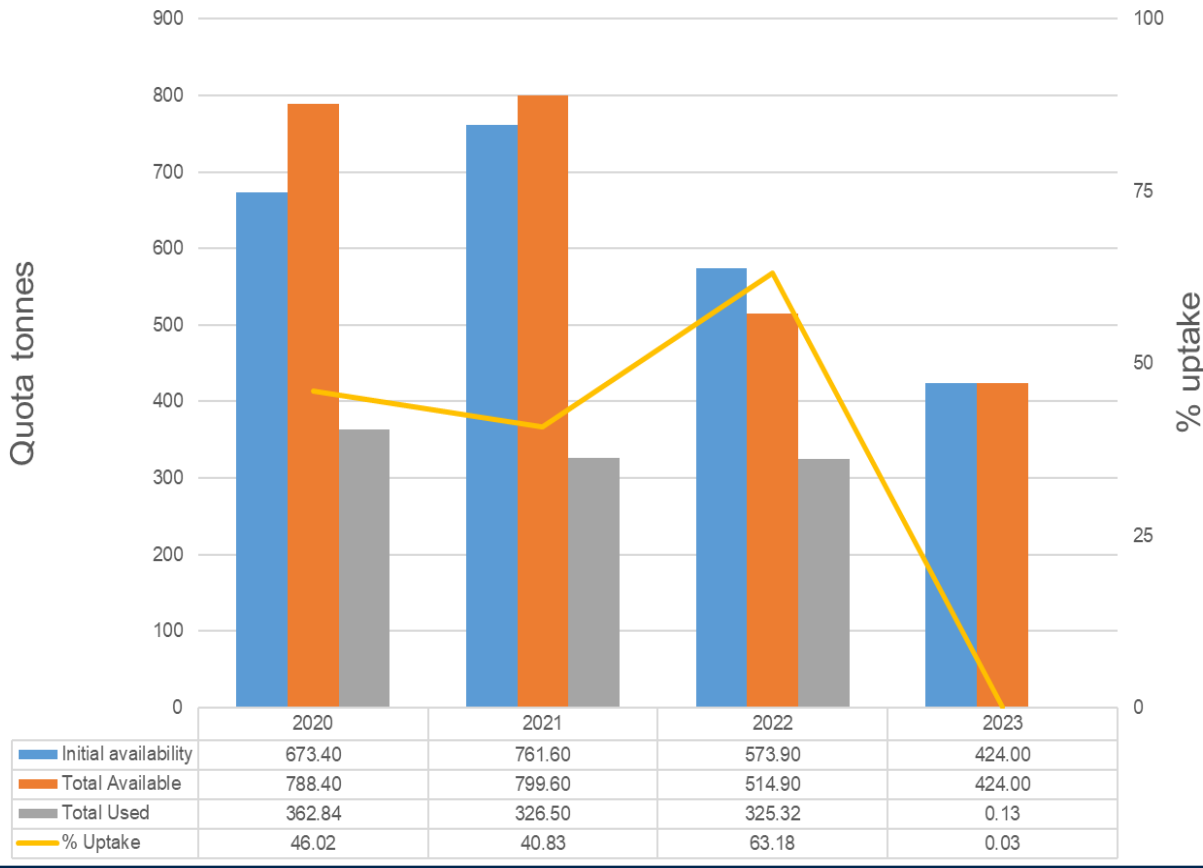

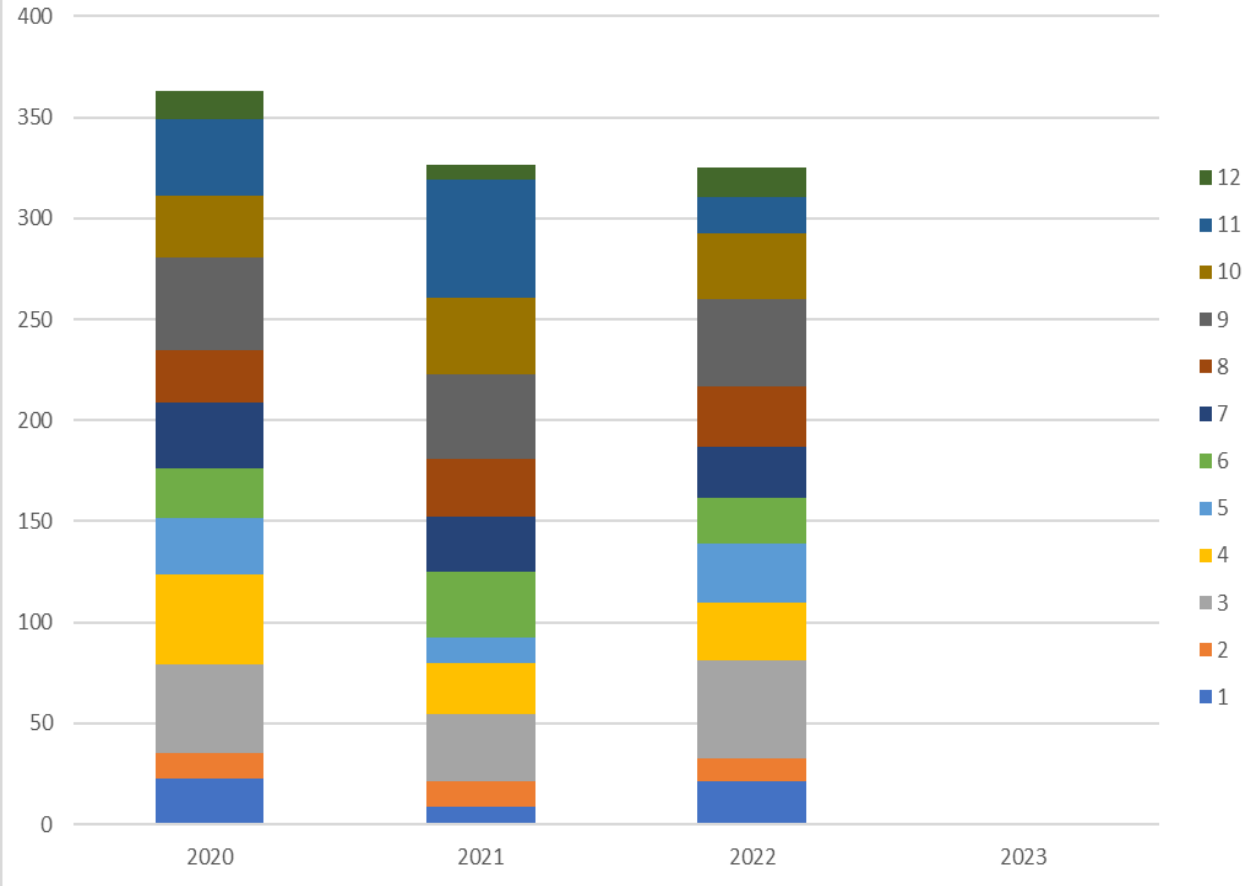

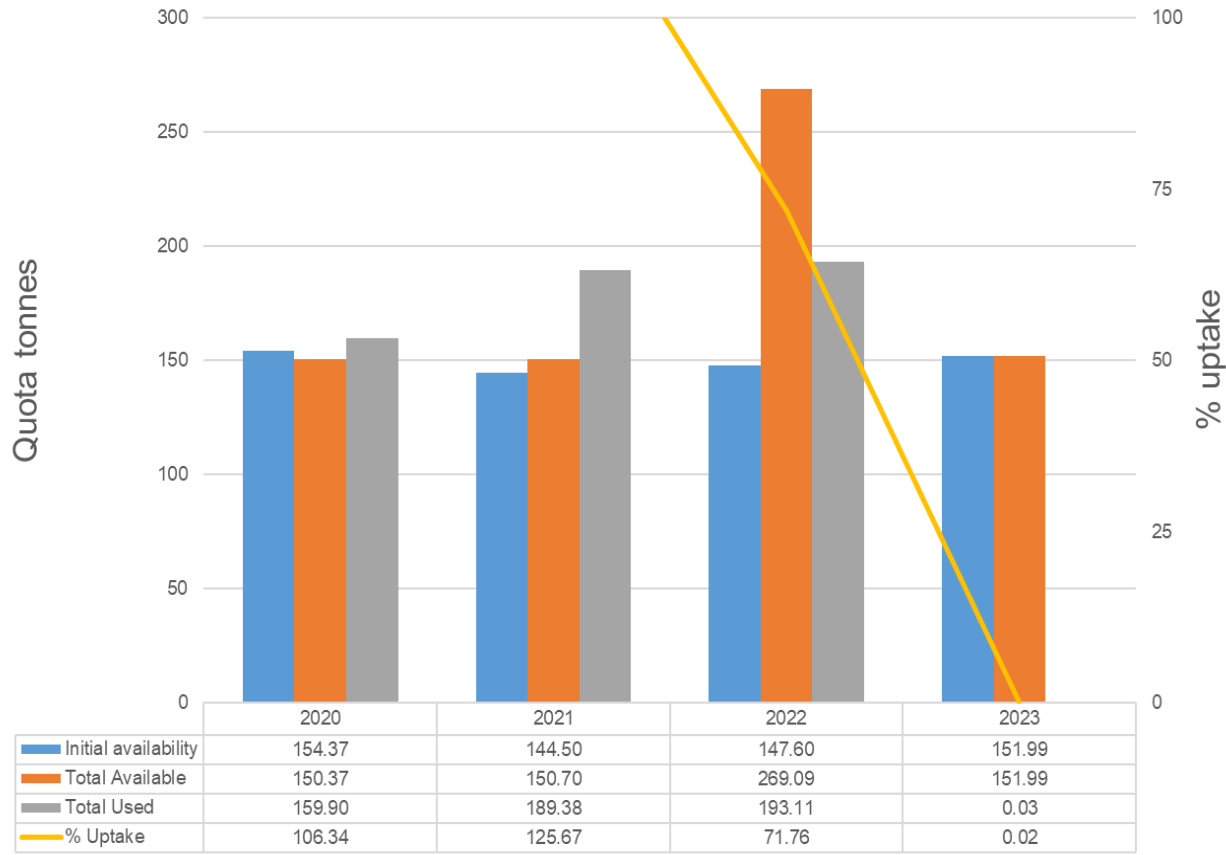

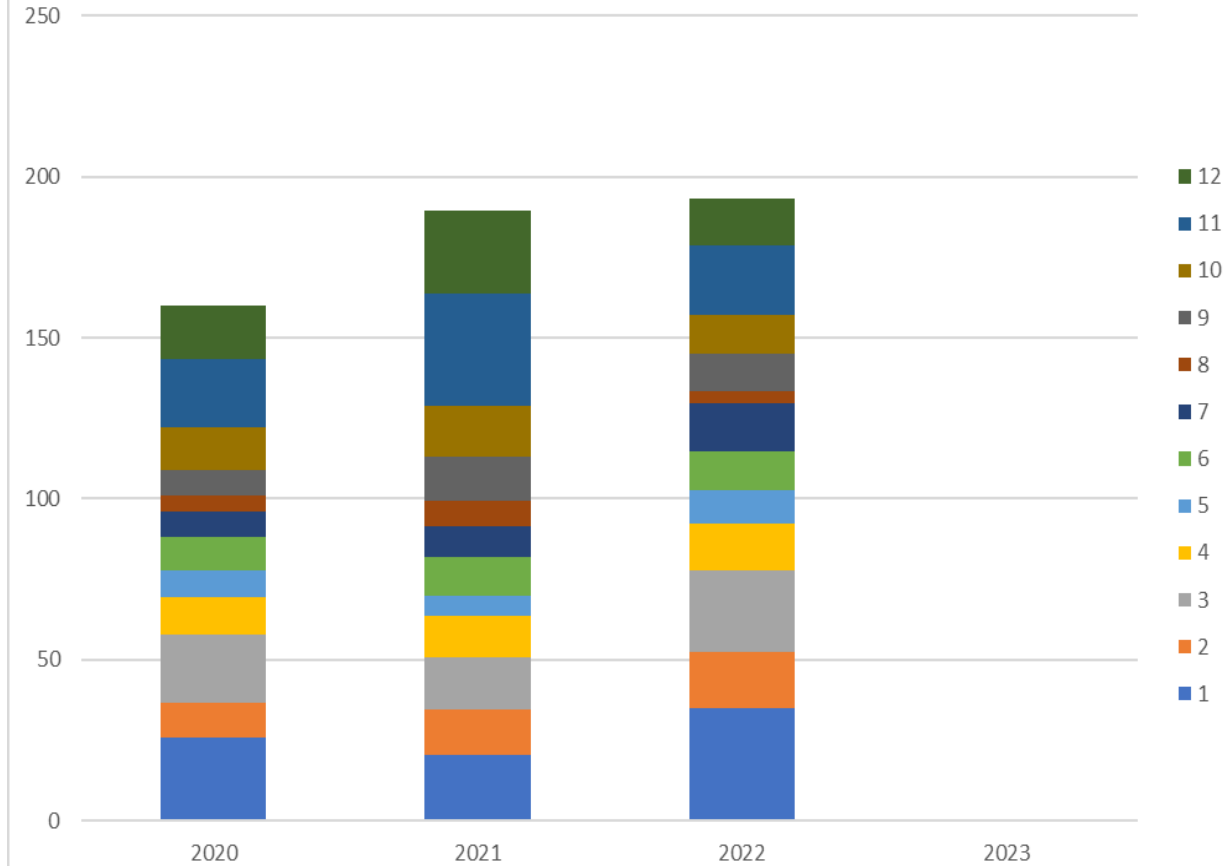
# Skates and Rays 7d

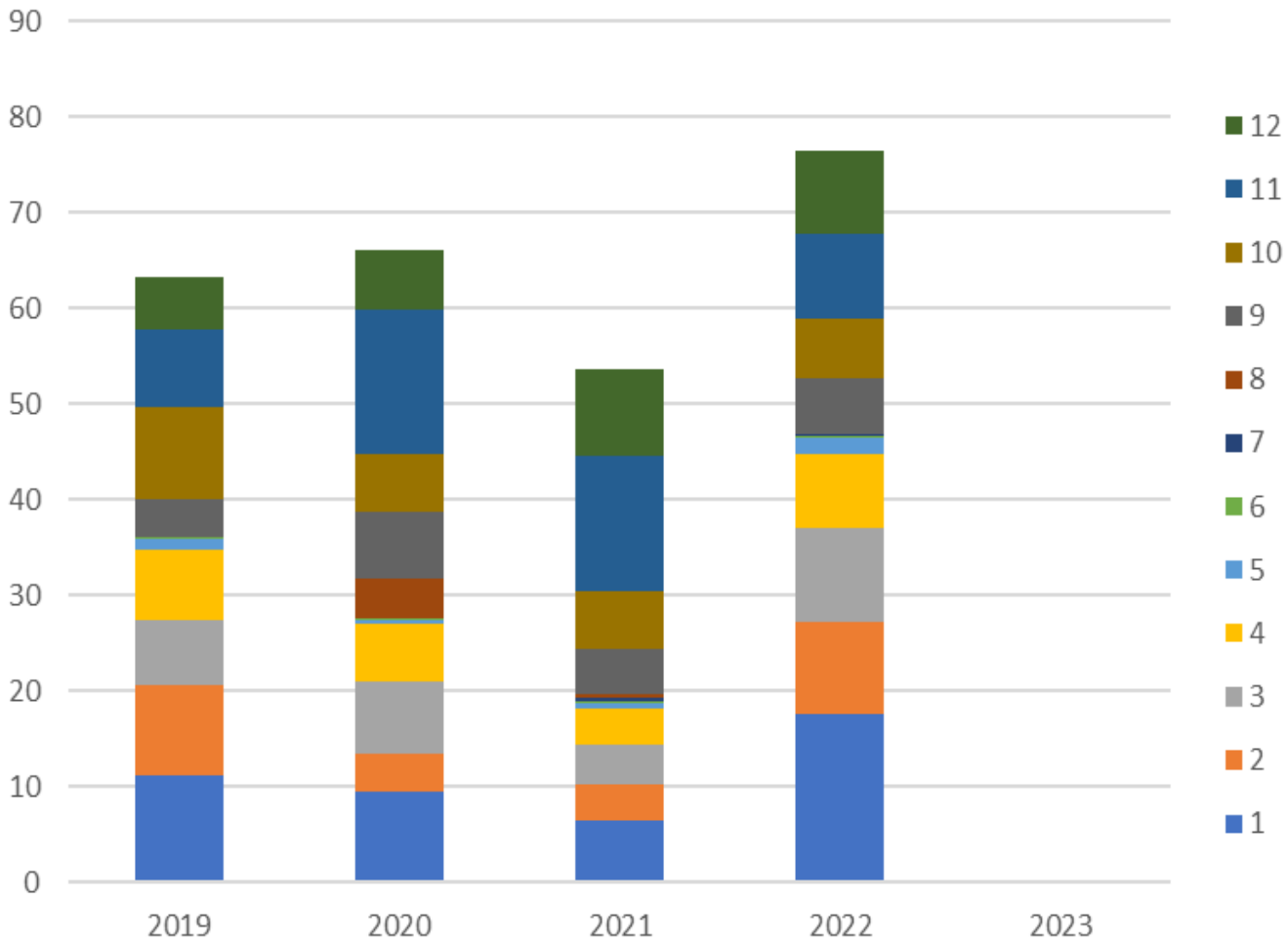

# Undulate Ray 7d & e

Monthly Uptake by Year - RJU - 7d&e



The UK and EU have agreed an increase in TAC for undulate ray in Area 7d/e for 2023

Increase from 75t in 2022

**UK 2023 allocation – 1051t**

Undulate ray can now be targeted in 7d/e

Restrictions on the minimum and maximum landing sizes and the closed period (May-August) still apply.

The fishery will continue to be regulated via the UK licence schedule.

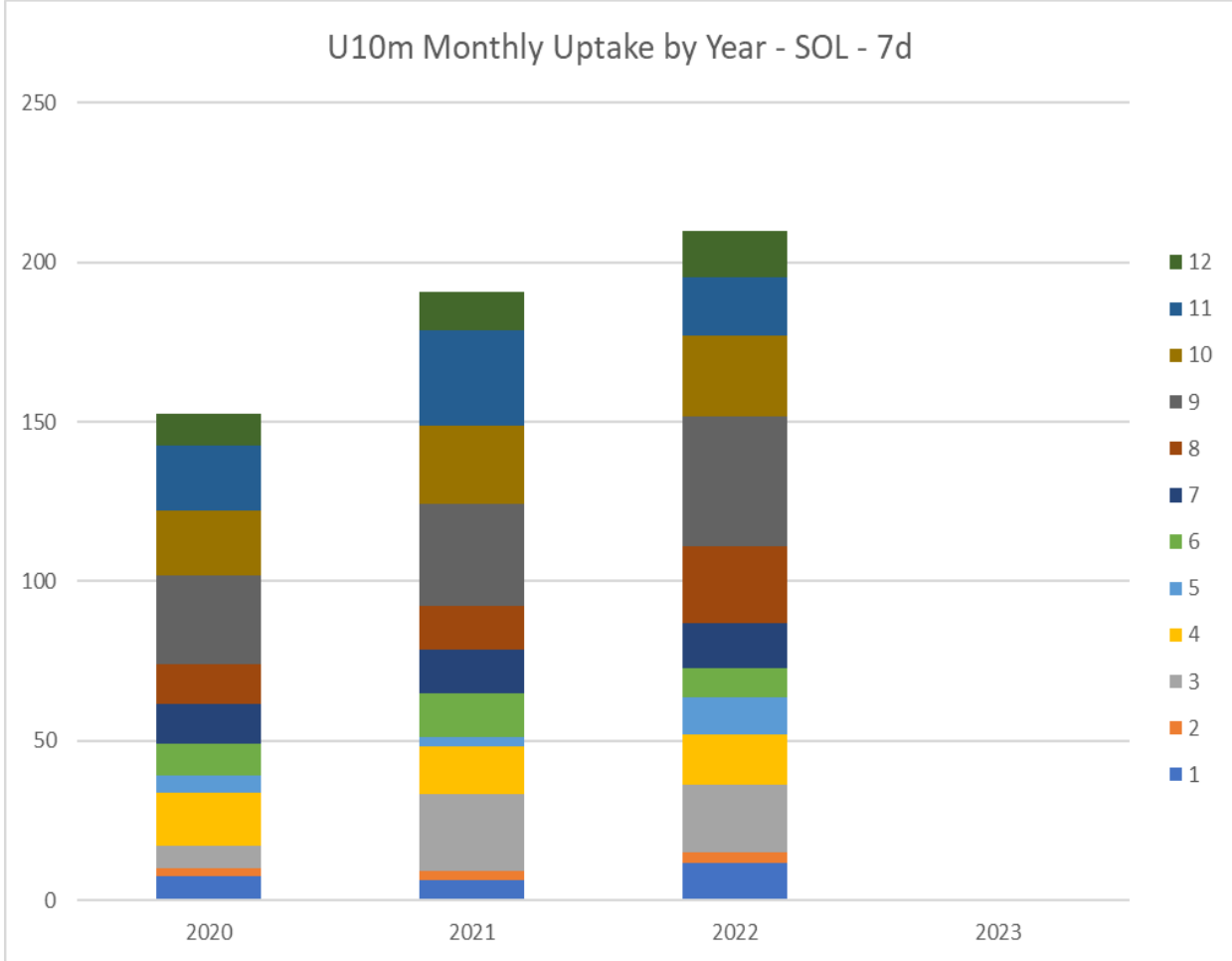
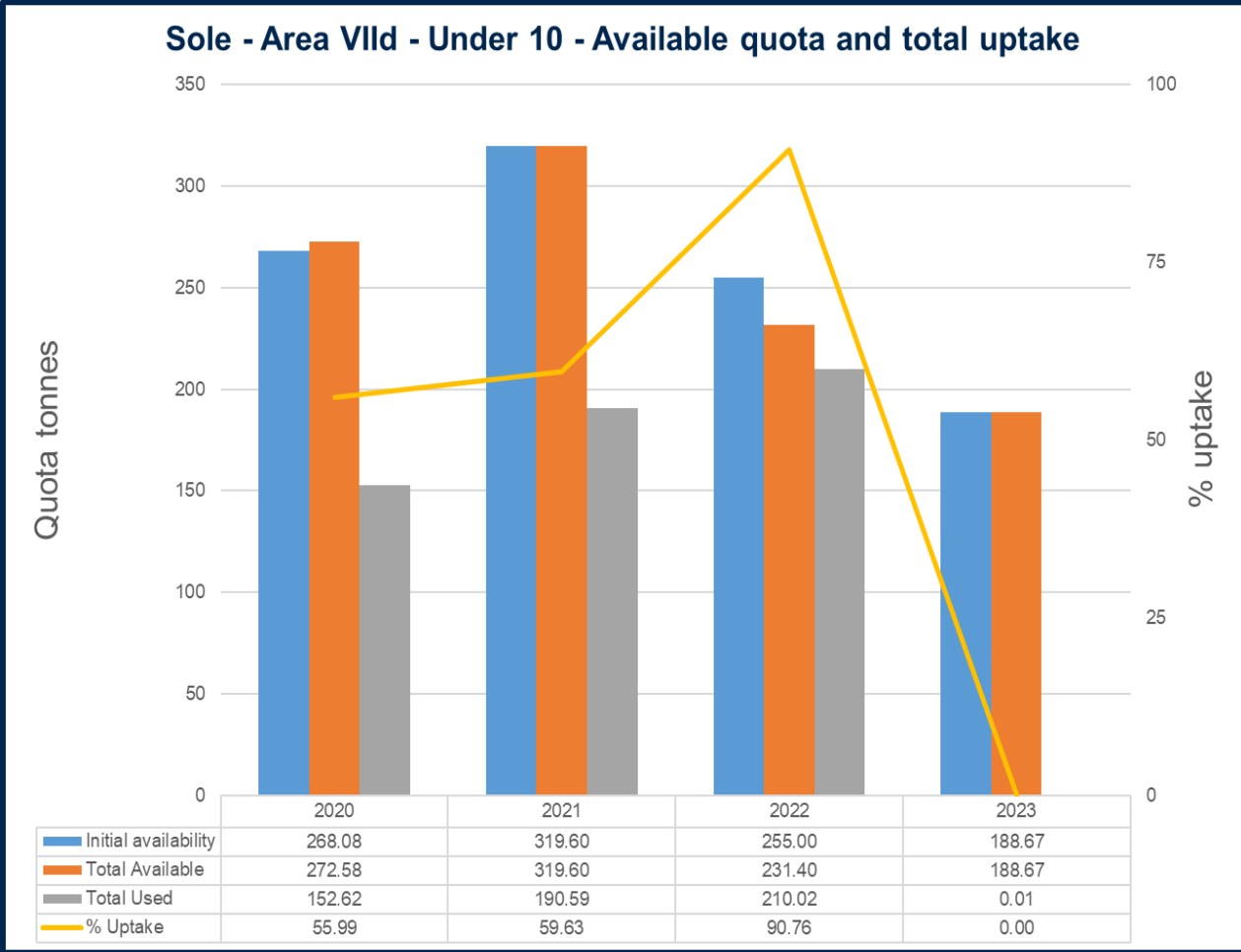
**Current Catch Limit – 200kg Per Trip**

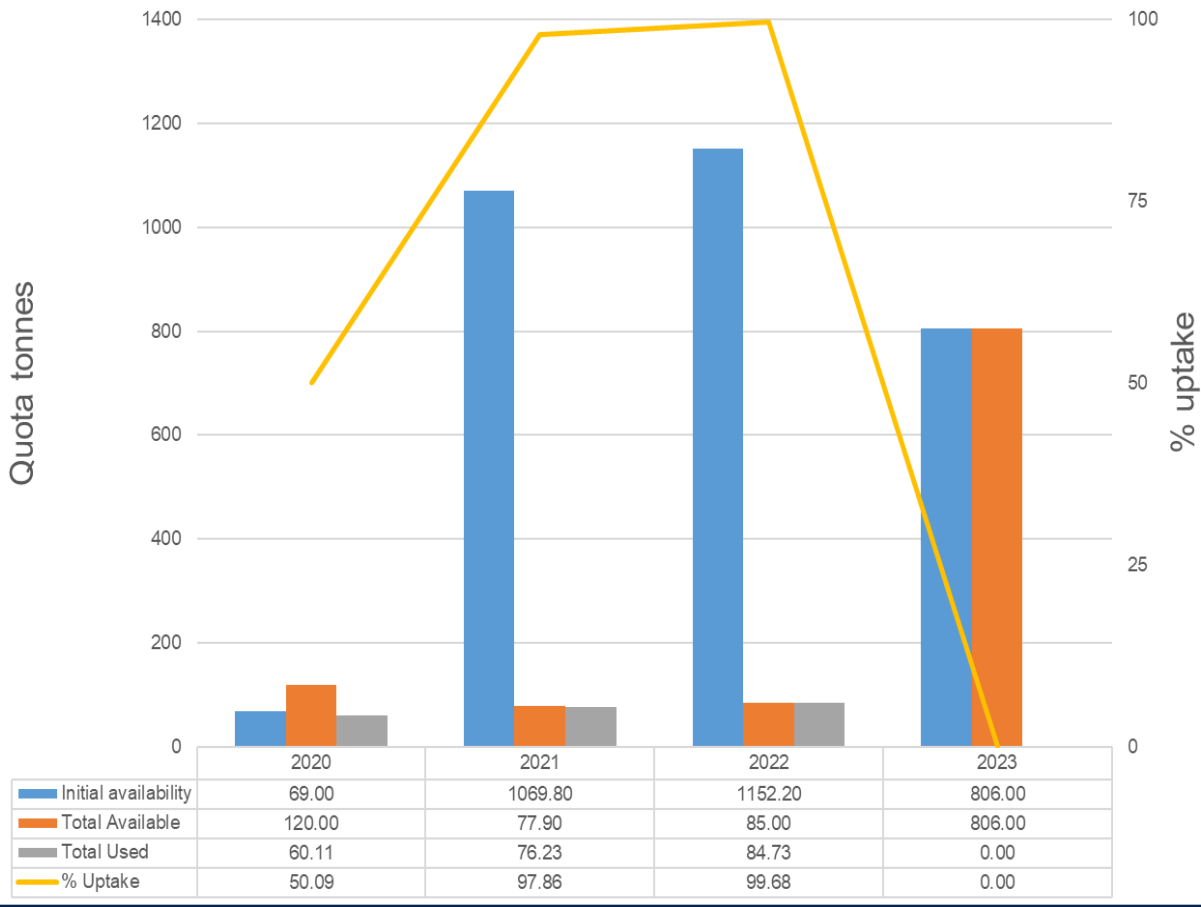

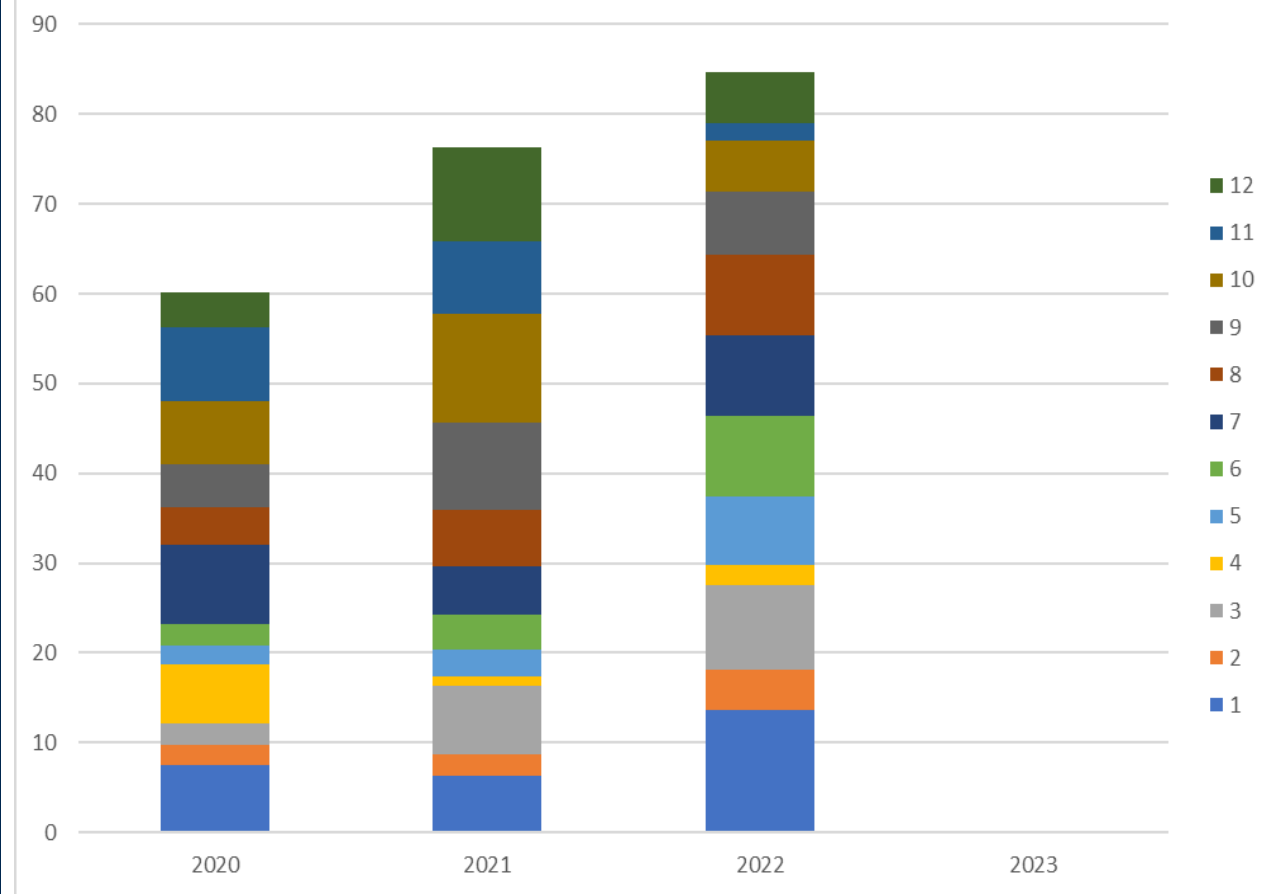

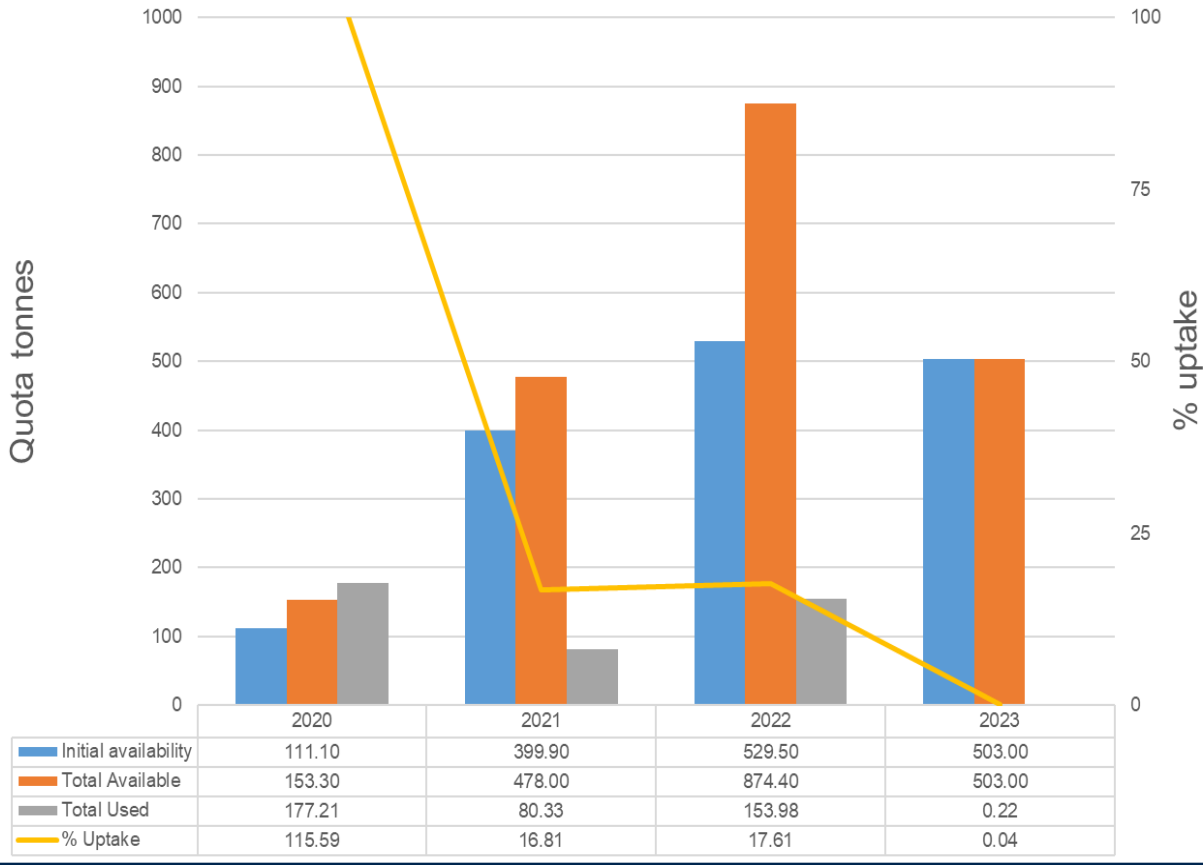

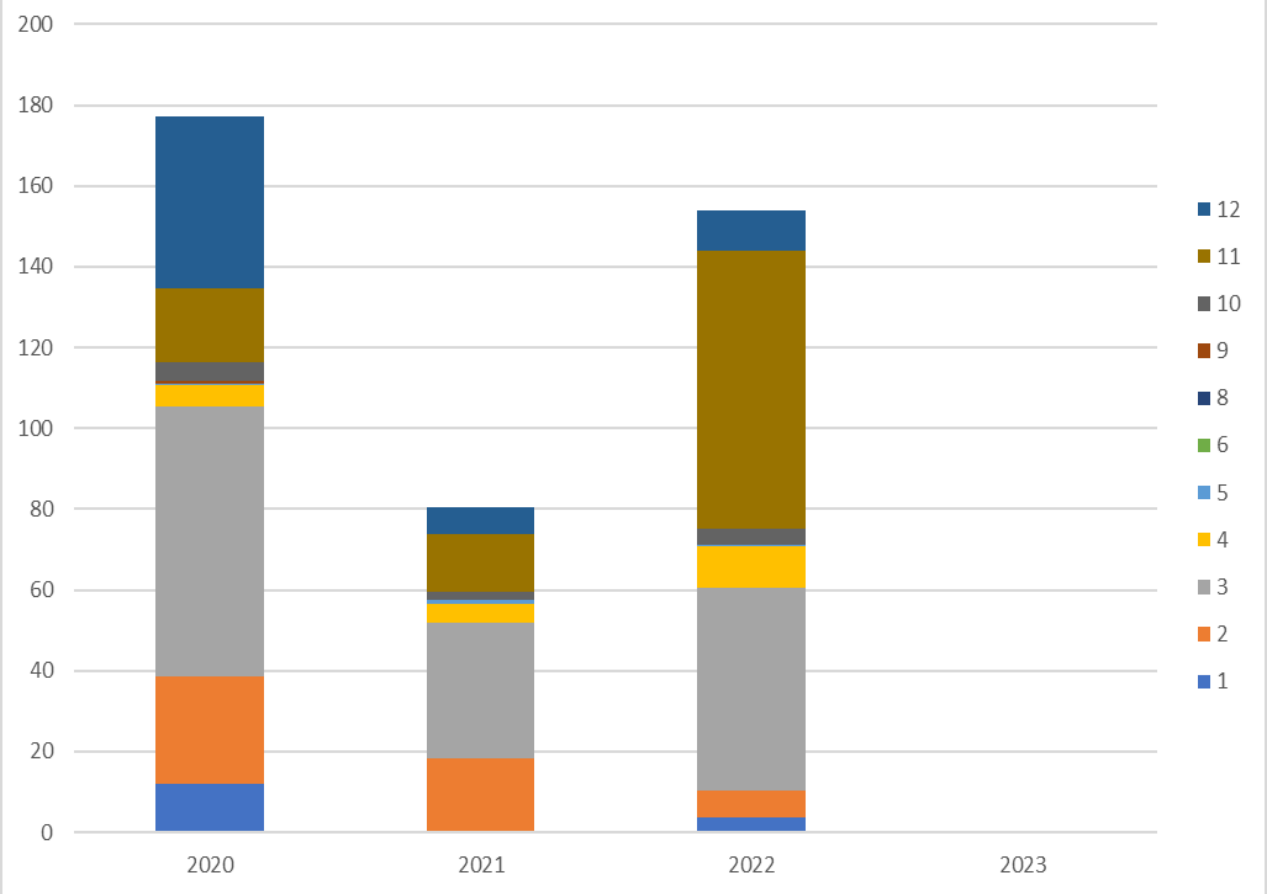
