- 1. It is declared that the Respondent breached the duties under sections 188 and 188A of the Trade Union & Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.
- 2. The Tribunal makes a protective award in respect of the Claimant who was dismissed as redundant on or after 12 June 2019.
- 3. The Tribunal orders the Respondent to pay to the Claimant remuneration for the protected period of 90 days beginning on 12 June 2019.
- 4. The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant a protective award of compensation in the sum of £4,274.32
