## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: OFFICERS SUBJECT TO RAPE/SEXUAL ASSULT COMPLAINTS.

We refer to your email dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2022 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2022.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

## Under freedom of information legislation, I am seeking the following information:

• The number of police officers within your force who have been subject to a complaint of rape or sexual assault between 2016 and 2021 and were serving at the time the complaint was made.

In respect of each complaint, please answer the following questions:

- In what calendar year was the complaint lodged?
- What rank was the officer in question?
- Was the complaint dealt with by local resolution?
- If so, was management action taken as a result?
- Did the complaint result in a misconduct meeting?
- If so, what was the outcome? For example, was the officer found to have committed misconduct or gross misconduct?
- Was the officer dismissed as a result of the complaint?
- Has the officer resigned or retired since the complaint was made?
- Did the complaint result in a criminal investigation?
- If so, was the officer subsequently a) arrested and b) charged?

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request. However, some information relating to your request is being withheld under section 40 – Personal Information of the Freedom of Information act.

## The number of police officers within your force who have been subject to a complaint of rape or sexual assault between 2016 and 2021 and were serving at the time the complaint was made.
