Assessment durations:

CBT Assessments last for two days; Monday and Tuesday or Wednesday and Thursday.

DAS Assessments last for ½ day.

Convictions:

Certified motorcycle instructors are required to undergo a basic DBS check. If you are not already a certified motorcycle instructor, then you must also submit a DBS certificate, issued in the last three months, with your application.

The applicant is required to give details of any motoring or non- motoring convictions. These will be taken into account when assessing suitability to attend the CBT or DAS Assessments and will have a bearing on whether a successful candidate is accepted onto the certified motorcycle instructor register, under the 'fit and proper' criteria.

This also applies to those subject to DVSA internal investigations where their application will be withheld.

All details of convictions, licence endorsements and disqualifications not yet spent should be declared.

Any offence committed between the submission of the application and attendance on the assessment, must be declared within 7 days of the conviction.

Assessment refusals:

All applications will be checked for suitability before an assessment date can be offered. We reserve the right to withhold an assessment date if there is an issue with an application, until such time as that issue is resolved.

If an applicant is already a certified motorcycle instructor, any information given by that applicant may be shared with the Approved Training Body if a query with the application should arise.

Unsuccessful assessments:

CBT Assessment

Should your performance within the instructor aspect of the assessment fail to meet the required standard, you will be subject to a standards check on return to your ATB. This will be conducted by a member of your local CBT team to ensure you can demonstrate continuing ability to deliver CBT to a satisfactory standard as required by the regulations.

The option is available to re-take the full assessment, taking into account that any individual failing the assessment on two occasions will be unable to re-attend for one year from the date of the second assessment.

DAS Assessment

The option is available to re-take the full assessment, taking into account that any individual failing the assessment on two occasions will be required to submit evidence of development. Upon receipt of satisfactory evidence, a third attempt may be offered. Any individual failing the third attempt will be unable to re-attend for one year from the date of the third assessment.

Successful DAS assessments:

You are not authorised to conduct any DAS training until you have received your instructor certificate.
