I am writing to inform you of my objection to this proposed planning application. My reasons are set out below :

Firstly the village of Elmdon is listed as an unsustainable village. There are only 2 buses a day, no shop, no pub and this proposed building application is on a green belt site.

From a personal point of view, we own and run Lofts Hall Stud and we have 50 thoroughbred mares, yearlings and foals here. We would travel approximately 150 times a year to Newmarket which would pass this proposed building site and the narrow road is already barely passable in our small horsebox. As it is, it's a very tricky navigation through the village.

As you aware, Elmdon has no street lighting and I gather from the proposed plans there would be external lighting. As this is an elevated position, it certainly would not be in keeping with the village.

I am also led to believe that there is a patch of woodland on the entrance to the site which does have active badger sets.

I am reliably told that the medical practices locally in Great Chesterford and Saffron Walden are already overloaded with work and under stress.
