The reasons for my objection are as follows:

1. Desecration of good grade 2 land that should be kept for producing farm produce - there are plenty of brown field sites and poorer wasteland available but further afield which is not considered because it would cost the solar farm builders more money to link it to the grid to the detriment of good farming land.
2. Eradication of a beautiful landscape full of rare birds such as the skylark and redcap.
3. Destruction of beautiful walks that my wife and I have been using for over 20 years and greatly enjoy.
