This form allows you to apply to import live fish and shellfish, as required under The Aquatic Animal Health (England and Wales) Regulations 2009. You must complete all sections of the form before it will be accepted.

- A site inspection may be required for imports of susceptible (coldwater) species for the ornamental trade, and for human consumption.
