JUDGMENT

The claimants' complaints of public interest disclosure detriments are struck out.

REASONS

1. The claimants were each ordered to pay a deposit of **£90** following a preliminary hearing held on **9 November 2022**. The Order was sent to the claimants on **18 November 2022**. The claimants have all failed to pay their deposits. The complaint of public interest disclosure detriment is therefore struck out under rule 39(4) of the **Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013**.
2. The claimants' claims for unauthorised deductions from wages will proceed to determination in line with the case management orders.
