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Converter Academy Orders

Points discussed in relation to school conversion.

Project: Discussion to consider Ashfield Primary School, Leeds, to convert and join Collaborative Learning Trust.

AB discussion:

- There is an existing relationship between Ashfield Primary and the Trust. They are geographically close, and the school believes the ethos of the Trust is aligned to their own.
- The Board considered the Trust's financial forecasts in light of current pressures on budgets and a School Resource Management Advisor (SRMA) was recommended.
- The age of the building was discussed, the Trust is to complete due diligence into the condition of the building.

Further actions required: SRMA to be deployed to the Trust. Delivery Officer to inform school/trust of decision

Project: Discussion to consider Lowerhouses CofE (Voluntary Controlled) Junior Infant and Early Years School, Kirklees, to convert and join Learning Accord Multi Academy Trust.

AB discussion:

- The school has considered a number of local Multi Academy Trusts and Learning Accord MAT has undertaken extensive due diligence on the school.
- It was considered that the school would bring capacity to the Trust in the form of experienced staff.
- An External Review of Governance was recommended to support the Trust in ensuring it operates effectively with appropriate separation between governance layers.
- The Board considered the Trust's financial forecasts in light of current pressures on budgets and a School Resource Management Advisor (SRMA) was recommended.

- It was considered that Highburton Church of England Voluntary Controlled First School would bring additional capacity to the Trust, and that the match made sense geographically.
- The Trust's School Improvement model was discussed, less external resource is expected to be used as the central team is strengthened.
- The Trust has high reserves, due to cancelled building projects during the pandemic, and a School Resource Management Advisor (SRMA) was recommended.
- The proposed conversion is supported by the Diocese.
- An External Review of Governance was recommended.

- The proposed conversion is supported by the Diocese.
- An External Review of Governance was recommended.
