All the data is taken from published annual reports , except age one, which is the sum of 4 quarters from the 2021 to 2022 quarterly reports (2021 to 2022 annual data has not yet been published). From age 6 and above, the data is taken from the 5 year age cohort. These show more children as 'Not fully vaccinated', because they are eligible for the pre-school booster (DTaP/IPV) and vaccine coverage for this fourth dose is always lower than for the 3 doses of the primary course (DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepR)
