Data on responses to correspondence from MPs and Peers Members' Correspondence in Q3 (July-September) 2022

The Government attaches great importance to the effective and timely handling of correspondence. The Cabinet Office is publishing this correspondence data to enable transparency and to demonstrate the total volume of correspondence received by Government Departments and Agencies from Members of Parliament and Peers between July and September 2022.

The deadlines set by Government Departments and Agencies for responding to correspondence from Members of Parliament and Peers should not exceed 20 working days, and Departments and Agencies are advised to consider setting more challenging deadlines than 20 working days to ensure a better minimum service level.

In Q3, the Government received a total of 70,833 cases of correspondence. Of these, 36,124 cases were responded to on time, at a performance rate of 51% against the 20 working day target outlined in the Guide to Handling Correspondence.
