JUDGMENT ON REMEDY

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The Claimant's application to amend his claim to include a claim for unpaid wages in the sum of \pounds 1,803.55 is dismissed.
- 2. There shall be no deduction from any compensation payable under the principle in Polkey v AE Dayton Services Ltd.
- 3. The Claimant did not contribute to his dismissal by reason of any blameworthy conduct and there shall be no reduction under s.122(2) Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 4. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant the total sum of £5,298.04 in respect of his unfair dismissal, calculated as follows:
 - a. Basic award in the agreed sum of £1005.10
 - b. Compensatory award of £2,282.74, calculated as follows:
 - i. Loss of earnings including pension loss of £2,580.32 net
 - ii. Loss of statutory rights £500
 - iii. Less the sum paid to the Claimant by the Respondent following his resignation of £1005.10
 - iv. Plus a 10% uplift on account of the Respondent's failure to follow the ACAS Code of Practice on Disciplinary Procedures.

c. An award of 4 weeks pay under section 38 of the Employment Act 2002 for failure to provide the claimant with a written statement of employment particulars, in the sum of £2010.20
