JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant's application to set aside the order of 24 August 2022 striking out her unfair dismissal claim on the basis she did not have two years' service and the order of 18 September striking out her age discrimination claim is dismissed.
- 2. The claimants claim of notice pay is struck out as having no reasonable prospect of success.
- 3. The claimant's claim of race discrimination continues, and a further Order have been made in respect of that.
