Request to amend notes associated with this code set as follows:

CO – add a note: "Includes special schools for SCAP from 2023 onwards.

FO – add a note: "Includes special schools for SCAP from 2023 onwards

CA – add a note: "Includes special schools for SCAP from 2023 onwards

NM – remove not saying this code is not valid for SCAP

(NB – the note saying that IN is not valid for SCAP should remain).

Reason for change (including benefits)

SCAP does not currently collect capacity data for specialist places and institutions, or associated pupil forecasts. The absence of this data means that:

- i. The department's Pupil Place Planning (PPP) Advisers and SEND Advisers are constrained in their ability to support and challenge local authorities on the sufficiency of local state provision.
- ii. DfE and LAs are collectively unable to quantify the overall level of specialist capacity in the system, including demand for additional places. This makes it difficult for LAs to quantify and articulate to DfE the place pressures they are facing, current levels of overcrowding and their forecasts of future pressures, hindering their ability to receive appropriate support and/or funding. The DfE is in turn constrained in its ability to articulate and provide evidence to the strategic centre of government as to the level of need for additional investment.
- iii. When delivering existing capital funding streams, we must rely on proxy metrics rather than local data on need. If capital investment is not targeted appropriately this may undermine our collective efforts to control wider system costs.

Improved data would also support a wide range of other critical departmental policy and operational functions, including the assessment and delivery of central capital programmes (such as free schools); high needs interventions (the 'safety valve' and Delivering Better Value); and broader SEN/AP policy.

Furthermore, instituting the collection of existing SEND capacity and associated forecasts for specialist placements via SCAP would be a powerful driver for desired wider behavioural change, encouraging LAs to further develop their capability for producing robust data on SEND demand (which can then be acted on by their local policy and strategy teams).

The amendment to the Governance code set is to reflect the changes described above.
