## JUDGMENT

1. The respondent discriminated against the claimant in treating her unfavourably because of something arising from her disabilities in January 2021 (allegation 4).

2. This complaint was part of conduct the last part of which, allegation 5, fell within the time limit for presenting a claim.

3. The respondent breached its duty to make adjustments for the claimant upon her return to work in April 2021 (allegation 5).

4. The claims of direct sex discrimination, direct disability discrimination, victimisation, constructive unfair dismissal and breach of contract or unauthorised deductions from wages are dismissed.

5. The respondent shall pay to the claimant compensation for the unlawful discrimination in the sum of £4,971.94, comprising an award for injury to feelings of ££4,613.34 including interest and £358.60 in respect of a week's pay, inclusive of interest.
