JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claims of age, race and disability discrimination are dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 2. The claimant's claim of unfair dismissal pursuant to s98 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 ("ERA") is struck out as the tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider the claim.
- 3. The claimant's claims of automatic unfair dismissal (s103A ERA) and detriment (s47B) are struck out as having no reasonable prospect of success.
