- 1) The Secretary of State makes this declaration to end the Protection Zone and revoke the Surveillance Zone declared at 20:30 on 21 October 2022 in accordance with articles with articles 4(1)(e) and 36(1), (2) and (3)) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No. 2) Order 2006<sup>1</sup> (as amended).
- 2) This ending of the Protection Zone and the revocation of the Surveillance Zone takes effect from 16:30 on 7 April 2023, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 3 kilometre Protection Zone and 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone in England, centred on grid reference TG1106414868 declared on 21 October 2022.
