JUDGMENT

The judgment of the tribunal is that:-

- 1. The claimant's claim that she was unfairly dismissed is well founded and is upheld.
- 2. The claimant's claim that she was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a statutory redundancy payment is well founded and is upheld.
- 3. The claimant's claim that she has accrued but unpaid holiday pay is well founded and is upheld.
- 4. The claimant's claim that the respondent is in breach of contract in the failure to pay notice pay in full is well founded and is upheld.

5. Directions in respect of remedy are given in the accompanying Case Management Order.
