Claimant: Miss Christina Boyce

Respondent: Seven Sisters Limited (in Voluntary Liquidation)

JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's claim in respect of unauthorised deduction from wages is well-founded. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £922.13 in respect of this claim.
2. The Claimant's claim in respect of a statutory redundancy payment is well-founded. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £1,064 in respect of this claim.

REASONS

1. This matter was previously listed for case management on 3rd February 2023. The Respondent did not attend and was not represented. The Respondent was ordered to write to the Tribunal and the Claimant stating whether it would defend the claim and whether it objected to judgment being entered for the sums claimed.
2. The case management orders made clear that should the Respondent fail to make any representations by 17th February 2023, judgment for the Claimant would be entered for the sums claimed. The Respondent has failed to make any representations.
