Re: S31 Grant Determination Letter for Devolution of the Adult Education Budget for Financial Year 2022-23 – Additional Funding: No. 31/6544 (DfE Grant Reference: AEBDEVO-22-23)

This Determination is made between:

- (1) The Secretary of State for Education and
- (2) Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority Greater Manchester Combined Authority Liverpool City Region Combined Authority North of Tyne Combined Authority South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority Tees Valley Combined Authority West Midlands Combined Authority West Yorkshire Combined Authority West of England Mayoral Combined Authority

This letter confirms the additional amount of devolved Adult Education Budget (AEB) you will receive in the financial year (FY) 2022-23 for the period 1 August 2022 to 31 March 2023 to deliver relevant adult education functions in your devolved area.

#### Payment arrangements

Your additional devolved AEB for the period 1 August 2022 to 31 March 2023 is set

out in the table in Annex A and will be paid by mid-March 2023.

We are making this additional payment because we are changing the basis on which we calculate your budget across academic and financial years as follows:

	Current	New – with effect from 1 August 2022	Difference
1 August 2022 – 31 March 2023	62.35%	66.67%	+4.02%
1 April – 31 July 2023	37.35%	33.33%	-4.02%

This additional payment brings forward 4.02% of the payment due to you in respect of the period 1 April to 31 July 2023 from the 2023-24 FY to the 2022-23 FY (see letter of <u>31/6040</u>). The amount due to be paid to you in April 2023 in respect of the period 1 April to 31 July 2023, as notified in March 2022, will be reduced by a corresponding 4.02%. The amount you shall receive for the 2022/23 academic year remains unchanged overall.

We are providing this grant as a Section 31 (S31) non-ring-fenced transfer under the Local Government Act 2003 and have copied this grant letter to the Chief Finance Officer of your Combined Authority for information.

#### Assurance arrangements

Your Combined Authority must have regard to the National Local Growth Assurance Framework<sup>1</sup>, including Adult Education Budget guidelines. The current version of the framework was published in September 2021 by the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities and clarifies what assurances should be in place when administering adult education functions.

In addition, the Department for Education also has an associated Memorandum of Understanding in place with your Combined Authority in relation to the devolution of adult education functions.
