1. Update on recent findings

The data presented under 'Update on recent findings' are obtained from clinical samples submitted for diagnostic purposes by private veterinary surgeons to the network of government laboratories and their partner providers in England and Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland, from ongoing monitoring of healthy livestock, and investigations of human *Salmonella* outbreaks in those regions.

The results presented in this section are preliminary and subject to change. The final annual figures will be published in the 'Salmonella in Livestock Production in Great Britain' and the 'UK-VARSS' annual reports and will be made available via GOV.UK.

1.1 England and Wales

- Multi-drug resistant (MDR) S. Rissen was detected in a dog.
- MDR S. Newport was detected in a pig.
- An extended-spectrum beta-lactamase (ESBL) producing *E. coli* was detected in a pig with intestinal torsion.
- Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA) was detected in piglets.

1.2. Scotland

- S. Typhimurium ST19 was detected in cows and wild birds.
- An ESBL-producing *E. coli* was detected in a dog.
- Methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus pseudintermedius* was detected in dog urine.

1.3 Northern Ireland

- MDR S. Typhimurium and a monophasic S. Typhimurium were detected in pigs.
- Phenotypic ESBLs were detected in calves and a piglet.
- MDR S. Infantis was detected in retail meat.
