# **JUDGMENT**

- The judgment of the Tribunal is that the claims 2205726/2020, 2205727/2020, 2205728/2020, 2205729/2020, 2205730/2020, 2205731/2020, and 2205712/2020, 2205711/2020, 2205713/2020, made under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 of a failure by the first respondent to comply with the requirements of section 188 of the 1992 Act are well-founded.
- 2. The Tribunal makes the following protective awards under section 189(3) of the 1992 Act.
  - a. The respondent must pay to employees dismissed on 14 May 2020 from the London Heathrow Terminal 4 and Terminal 5 restaurants, remuneration for the period of 90 days beginning on 14 May 2020.
  - b. The respondent must pay to the employees dismissed on 13 May 2020 from the London Smithfield restaurant, remuneration for the period of 90 days beginning on 13 May 2020.
- 3. The Recoupment Regulations apply to the awards in paragraph 2.

4. The claims numbered 2205694/2020, 2205695/20, 2205696/20, 2205697/20 and 2205698/20 are not well-founded and are dismissed.
