

**Copy of Distribution plan for additional risk minimisation materials relevant to PL 15764/156 and 157**

**Planned distribution path:**

HCP check list: The HCP check list will be made available on the electronic medicines compendium website (<https://www.medicines.org.uk/emc>). HCP can download the checklist at the time of initiation of dose.

Patient alert card: The patient alert card will be made available on the electronic medicines compendium website (<https://www.medicines.org.uk/emc>). The patient caregiver can download the alert card when required.

To ensure that key prescribers/doctors are aware of the need to discuss with the caregiver the medicine, the dosing regimen and side effect monitoring, and then provide and explain the Patient Alert Card to the caregiver, we shall contact the NHS trusts, Clinical commissioning groups (CCGs), the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE), the British National Formulary (BNF) as well as reach out to GPs through the GP surgery software providers so that the educational material is flagged when a GP writes a prescription for our product. In addition we will also communicate with neurologists, paediatric neurologist and chief hospital pharmacist and chief pharmacists of the major pharmacy chains either by email or letter to advise of the availability and location of the Educational Materials and the need for additional education to the patient caregiver for Glycopyrronium bromide tablets.
