Costs JUDGMENT

- 1. Following a liability judgment on 10 August 2022 in which the claimant's complaint of race discrimination failed the respondent made an application for costs which was heard on 28 February and 3 March 2023. A deposit order had been made in July 2021 in respect of each of the allegations. The complaint failed for the reasons set out in the Deposit Order.
- 2. The claimant and respondent each made written and oral submissions on costs. The respondent provided a schedule of costs and the claimant a counter schedule. The claimant gave evidence as to his ability to pay.
- The Tribunal finds the claimant acted vexatiously, abusively and otherwise unreasonably in pursuing his complaint and exercised its discretion to award costs.
- 4. The claimant is ordered to pay to the respondent £18,975* made up as follows:

Solicitors costs of	£	12462.50
Counsel's fees of	£	3850.00
Vat on each of the above	£	3262.50

Less £ 600 paid by the respondent as deposit which money should now be released to the respondent.

5. * The figure given in oral judgment today (of £19 575) did not allow for the offset of the £600 deposit paid so this judgment is corrected in that regard.
