	<p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that the animals herein described meet the following requirements:</p> <p>II.1. The animals have been kept in captivity in the country of origin mentioned in box I.7. since birth or for at least six months before export</p> <p>II.2. The holding and the area within a 10 km radius around the holding have been free of and are not under any official animal health control measures with respect to WOAHA-listed diseases, which may be transmitted by the animals listed in this certificate, for at least 40 days before loading.</p> <p>II.3. The animals have been examined at the place of origin within 24 hours before loading, were free from clinical evidence of infectious or contagious diseases or external parasites and fit for transport</p> <p>II.4. The vehicles, containers and all removable equipment for the transport of the animals have been used for the first time or have been cleaned and disinfected before loading</p> <p>II.5. During transport to the place of loading and during transit to Switzerland the animals were not transported with animals that do not meet the criteria for export to Switzerland</p>

**Part I:**

• Box I.2.: A separate certificate is to be provided for each consignment and the original must accompany the consignment to the border inspection post (BIP) in the EU or Switzerland.

The period of validity is 10 days.

• Box I.11.: Name of the city or place where the animals/products are loaded

• Box I.16.: CITES permit, airway bill, etc.

• Box I.18.: Use the appropriate HS codes: 0106.1200 / 0106.1900

• Box I.21.: Individual identification must be used if possible. In case of small animals, batch identification can be used.

Age: Date of birth (dd/mm/yyyy) if possible

Sex (M = male, F = female, C = castrated).
