

Thank you for your request for information which was processed in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You requested the following information:

Further your news article (now withdrawn) first published 24 October 2019


[Withdrawn] £38 million Homes England funding to speed up development of over 2,000 homes - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) and a historic Freedom of Act enquiry RFI2830.

- 1. May I please ask, of the £14, 677,800 allotted to Cheshire West and Chester Council to build 737 houses across 5 sites how much money was allotted specifically to site ACo12-07 LAPA Fields in Chester and how much money has been paid to this Council for this specific site to date?
- 2. If this money has not yet been paid out for this site (partially or in full), is the allotted amount still available for the Council to take at a future date please?
- 3. Please can you tell me how was the site at LAPA Fields was described by the Council in their application for this funding?
- 4. Has Cheshire West and Chester Council made any other bids under any scheme that you administer to Homes England for funding in Chester and if so, could you please provide brief details?

We asked for clarification as to the timescale you were seeking the information for question 4 in your request and you advised you were seeking this information from October 2019 to date.

Response

We can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request. We will address each of your questions in turn.

1. May I please ask, of the £14, 677,800 allotted to Cheshire West and Chester Council to build 737 houses across 5 sites how much money was allotted specifically to site ACo12-07 LAPA Fields in Chester and how much money has been paid to this Council for this specific site to date?

The funding allocated to Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council for this site was £3.06 million.

According to our records no funding has been paid out by Homes England to Cheshire West and Chester Council for this site.

2. If this money has not yet been paid out for this site (partially or in full), is the allotted amount still available for the Council to take at a future date please?

The funding was provided under the Local Authority Accelerated Construction (LAAC) Programme. The terms of the funding were set out in the Grant Funding Agreement between Homes England and Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council.

The funding availability period detailed in the Grant Funding Agreement was up to and including 31 March 2021. The LAAC programme is now closed and no new bids for funding are accepted.

3. Please can you tell me how was the site at LAPA Fields was described by the Council in their application for this funding?

The application was to use the funding to develop the site for residential housing. The number of units proposed was 90 residential units, 50% of which were to be affordable housing.

4. Has Cheshire West and Chester Council made any other bids under any scheme that you administer to Homes England for funding in Chester and if so, could you please provide brief details?
