## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. On 30 March 2022:
- a) The first respondent's premises at London Road, Penrhos Works,
  Holyhead LL65 2UX constituted an establishment for the purpose of S188 of the Trade
  - Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 ("TULR(C)A 1992");
- b) There was no recognised trade union or appointed or elected employee representatives for the purpose of S188 (1B) of TULR(C)A 1992.
- 2. The claimants complaints that the First Respondent failed to comply with a requirement of S188 of TULR(C)A 1992 is upheld.

- 3. The Tribunal makes a protective award in favour of the claimants.
- 4. The First Respondent is ordered to pay to the claimants remuneration for the protected period of 90 days beginning on 31 March 2022.
