## JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is:

- 1. The claimant was constructively unfairly dismissed by the respondent on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2021. His claim of Unfair Dismissal is well-founded and succeeds.
- 2. At all material times the claimant was a disabled person and the respondent had knowledge of disability.
- 3. The claimant's claims of disability discrimination fail and are dismissed, namely:
  - a. Discrimination arising from disability
  - b. Harassment
  - c. Failure to make reasonable adjustments.
- 4. The claimant's claim that the respondent breached his contract of employment with regard to the payment of utility bills and expenses fails and is dismissed.
- 5. The claimant's claim that he was entitled to a redundancy payment is dismissed upon withdrawal.
