## How we will look after your personal information



We are **the Department of Health and Social Care**.

We are part of the UK government.

We help lead health and **social care** in the UK.

We are doing this **consultation** to find out what skills and experience you think are important for adult social care workers.

To do this work we might need people's **personal information**.

**Personal information** means anything that can be used to find out who you are and how to contact you.

In this **consultation**, we ask if you want to give us your

- name
- phone number
- email address



## How we will use your information

We might use this information to ask you more about your ideas for adult social care.



## Making sure we follow the law

The law says that we must carefully look after your personal information.



This law is called the General Data Protection Regulations.

We call it **GDPR** for short.



The GDPR gives people **rights** about how organisations keep their personal information.

## How we will keep your information safe

We will keep your personal information safe on our government computers.

Only people who work with us can use your information.

## Your rights

The GDPR law says you have **rights** about your information.



1. You have the right to ask for a copy of your personal information.



2. You have the right to make sure the personal information we have is correct.



3. You have the right to tell us how you want us to use your personal information.



4. You have the right to say if you do not like how we use your personal information.



5. You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information.
