- Form **PSVV 1** must be used when applying for a **Vitesse 100** examination whether or not it is intended to have another examination carried out at the same time e.g. Certificate of Initial Fitness examination.
- It is essential to give the identification mark of the vehicle. If the vehicle has been registered, give the registration mark and chassis number, even if it is not currently licensed. If it is not registered, give the chassis number (see question 2b).
