JUDGMENT

- 1. The claims for unauthorised deduction from wages under section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996, unlawful detriment under section 12 of the Employment Rights Act 1996, harassment related to race under section 26 of the Equality Act 2020, and direct discrimination on grounds of race and/or disability in withholding sick pay under section 13 of the Equality Act 2010 are dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 2. The claim for wrongful dismissal succeeds on the Respondent's admission of liability. The remedy to which the Claimant is entitled will be determined at the hearing on 16 May 2023.
- 3. The claims of direct discrimination on grounds of race and/or disability under section 13 of the Equality Act 2010 and the claim of the Respondent failing to make a reasonable adjustment in not placing the Claimant on the Furlough Scheme under section 20 and 21 of the Equality Act 2010 are struck out under rule 37(1) of Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 as having no reasonable prospect of success.
