JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deduction of wages is well founded. The Respondent must pay the Claimant £3,227.03 gross. It is the Claimant's responsibility to ensure that the correct amount of tax is paid.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for breach of contract is well founded but there is no award since he is already compensated through loss of wages.
