JUDGMENT

- 1. The claims of disability discrimination for a breach of the duty to make reasonable adjustments and harassment, victimisation and being subject to detriments for making protected disclosures are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 2. The respondent did not provide the claimant with written terms and particulars of his employment before the issue of these proceedings, but no award is payable in respect of that failure because the above claims did not succeed.
- 3. The claimant acted vexatiously, abusively, disruptively and otherwise unreasonably in the conduct of these proceedings. Having regard to all the circumstances the claimant shall pay to the respondent the sum of £20,000 as part of its costs of legal representation.
